BCOA Mentor Revisions Draft

BCOA MENTOR GUIDELINES

Mentors may be approved by the BCOA Board of Directors after meeting the following mandatory qualifications: and completion of the application process.

- 1. Be a BCOA member in good standing (single, household, or lifetime) for a minimum of 15 informal years.
- 2. Have good personal communication skills with the ability to do public speaking.
- 3. Have a minimum of 15 years of continuous personal experience in breeding as well as competitive borzoi breed specific events.
- 4. Must have bred and raised at least 5 litters and have owned and exhibited at least 10 borzoi to AKC and/and ASFA championship titles.
- 5. Have attended and completed in its entirety BCOA sponsored Judges Breed Seminar including the hands-on presentation.
- 6. Be knowledgeable of the history and original purpose of borzoi.
- 7. Supports the BCOA breed standard and accompanying BCOA Visualization of the Standard.
- 8. Competent to share knowledge and provide guidance through open exchange of information in a positive and objective manner. Avoid any hint of bias pertaining to a specific line or style.

Additional Qualifications (check those that apply) 4 minimum required

- \Box Attended a minimum of 10 national specialties in 3 different regions.
- □ Earned AKC/ASFA coursing titles on at least two borzoi
- □ AKC/ASFA judge for at least 5 years
- □ Judged regular classes at a BCOA national or a regional specialty
- □ Judged BCOA National sweepstakes or futurity
- □ Participated as a panelist on Borzoi Breeder panel
- □ Provided ringside mentoring per AKC guidelines
