A2	Checks	10-16-1993 Chicago, IL	Checks Received: All checks made payable to the BCOA must be turned over to BCOA for deposit. It is a serious impropriety to countersign a check made payable to the BCOA and deposit it in a personal account.
A3	Checks- Applications	5-23-1993 Fife, WA	Allow membership application checks to be deposited immediately upon receipt
A4	Checks NSF	2-28-2008 phone conf.	Increase NSF fee from \$25 to \$35.

**BCOA Board Calendar**

Based on Constitution/By-Laws and standing rules. **Note that the By-Laws are in Quotes.**

January 1: “The elected Officers and Board members shall take office the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of January.”

January 1: “Dues shall be due on the first day of January of each year. “

January - Treasurer will provide the names of the new life members to the Corresponding Secretary. The Corresponding Secretary will provide certificates to be read and given out at the next Annual Membership meeting.

January 15 - final notices sent to members whose dues are not paid.

January 15 of odd years - Starting on January 15, the Recording secretary shall have a week to compile the Judges Breakdown Ballot with the list of all nominations. Reference standing rule G15 for the rest of the schedule for Judges Ballots.

First Board meeting of the year - Decide if a member should be given the AKC Good Sportsman medallion, to be presented at the National Specialty.

First Board meeting of the year - Governors will forward recommendations from members in their regions, for the AKC Lifetime Achievement Awards, to the Recording Secretary, in time for the first board meeting of the year.

## Borzoi Club of America - Current - Standing Rules

After 1 January and before 30 June: “At any Board of Directors meeting after the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of January and prior to the thirtieth (30<sup>th</sup>) day of June, the Board shall select a Nominating Committee consisting of three (3) members with two (2) alternates”. “The Recording Secretary shall notify the membership of the names, addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses of the Chairman and members of the Nominating Committee and the name and address of the independent tabulators no later than thirty (30) days after Board approval.”

March 1: “A membership will be considered as lapsed and automatically terminated if such member’s dues remain unpaid sixty (60) days after the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of the fiscal year. Upon payment of the current dues plus a \$10 late penalty by the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of March, a member in good standing who has lapsed shall be automatically reinstated.”

March 1: “The quorum shall be established on the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of March of each year and shall remain a constant figure for the remainder of the year. The quorum figure will be sent to the membership in the first available mailing after March 1. A quorum for such meetings shall be ten percent (10%) of the members in good standing.”

September 15: “The Nominating Committee report must be received by the Recording Secretary no later than the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) day of September. “

October 1: “The Recording Secretary shall, not later than the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of October, notify the entire membership by mail in writing of the candidates nominated.”

October 31 & November 15 - “If one or more valid additional nominations are received by the Recording Secretary on or before midnight on the thirty-first (31<sup>st</sup>) day of October, the Recording Secretary shall by the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) day of November, mail to each member by First Class mail a ballot listing, in alphabetical order, all of the candidates for each contested position, along with a brief profile of each candidate(s).”

November: “dues notice shall be mailed during the month of November of each year “

November of even years: Send Judges Nomination form with dues notice.

December 1: “By the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of December, the Recording Secretary shall send the tabulator designated for that year an alphabetical list of all members to whom ballots were sent.”

December 15: “The election of Officers, Regional Governors and Delegate to the American Kennel Club shall be conducted by secret ballot. Ballots, to be valid, must be received by the independent tabulator designated by the Board of Directors on or before the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) day of December.”

After December 15 and before 1 January: “The Recording Secretary shall obtain from the designated tabulator the certified results of the election and the names of the members who voted. Prior to the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of January, he/she shall notify those candidates elected.”

General - Every 5 years a special yearbook (pedigree book) will be published.

General - The recording secretary will provide a draft of the minutes to the officers (not the 6 governors) within 2 weeks of a Board meeting. Changes and additions must be returned to the Recording Secretary within 7 days.

General : “The Annual Meeting shall be held each year as designated by the Board of Directors. All members of the Club shall be notified by mail of the date, time and place of the meeting by the Recording Secretary at least thirty (30) days in advance of the meeting. “

General : “A meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held in conjunction with the Annual Membership Meeting. Other meetings of the Board shall be held at such times and places as are designated by the President or by a majority vote of the Board. **Written, fax or email notice of each such other meeting shall be sent by the Recording Secretary to each member of the Board no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting and not more than thirty (30) days prior to the meeting. This notice must include the President’s agenda.** Board members shall sign an authorization agreeing to email communication. Such authorization, which is revocable, will also release the club from any liability should the notification be received late or not received by the Board member due to circumstances beyond the Club’s control. Board members are required to notify the Recording Secretary immediately if they are unable to attend the meeting. Failure to make any attempt to attend meetings, or failure to notify the Recording Secretary concerning the inability to attend meetings, failure to return mail or email votes shall result in the Board considering that office for possible replacement. The quorum for such a meeting shall be a majority of the Board members. “

## Triathlon Rules

the ASFA total score divided by 4 when there are two judges,  
or the ASFA total score divided by 2 when there is one judge,  
or the AKC total score divided by 2 when there are two judges,  
or the AKC total score when there is one judge.  
(Single stakes entries are not eligible).

### Lure Coursing Bonus Points:

- Best of Breed - 20 points
- Overall second highest score - 15 points
- First In Stake - 12 points
- Second In Stake - 8 points
- Third In Stake - 5 points
- Fourth In Stake - 3 points

**LGRA:** The Base Score is 50 for a dog who completes three races in good standing (no fouls, no off course, not dismissed, not disqualified). Bonus points are one point for each dog defeated, capped at 25. The only dogs that count as dogs defeated, are those dogs who complete three races in good standing (no fouls, no off course, not dismissed, not disqualified).

### OBEDIENCE:

**Base Score** - For the regular classes (Novice, Open, Utility) and Veteran classes the Base Score is one-half (1/2) of total points earned (or 100 points maximum). For the optional-titling Beginner-Novice classes, the base score is one-half of total points earned times 90% (or 90 points maximum). For all obedience classes, a qualifying score in any exercise is used for points, even if the total score is Non-Qualifying (NQ).

### Bonus Points: (All bonus points require a qualifying score)

- High In Trial (Regular classes) - 20 points
- Highest Non-Regular (Veteran) class score if greater than High in Trial score - 15 points
- Overall second highest score (Regular classes) - 15 points
- First in Obedience Class - 12 points
- Second in Obedience Class - 8 points
- Third in Obedience Class - 5 points
- Fourth in Obedience Class - 3 points

### RALLY:

(Qualifying Score required). For the Rally-Novice classes, the Base Score is 80% of the points earned. For the Advanced and Excellent classes, the Base Score is the points earned.

### Bonus Points:

- First in Rally Class – 12 points
- Second in Rally Class – 8 points
- Third in Rally Class – 5 points
- Fourth in Rally Class – 3 points

**CONFORMATION Base Score:** Determined by the judge's evaluation of dog in the Triathlon Class, and is recorded on Conformation Score Sheet (100 points maximum).

- Best of Breed - 20 points
- Best Of Opposite Sex - 20 points
- Select Dog - 17.5 points
- Select Bitch - 17.5 points
- Winners Dog - 15 points
- Winners Bitch - 15 points
- Award of Merit - 15 points
- First In Conformation Class \*- 12 points

Second In Conformation Class \* - 8 points

Third In Conformation Class \* - 5 points

\* *Must defeat at least one dog to get conformation bonus points.*

If a dog qualifies in more than one bonus point category in any of these three events, he will only be awarded the higher bonus points. Example: A dog wins first in a lure coursing stake (12 points) and BOB (20 points), so the dog is awarded the higher points (20 points).

On the Triathlon Entry Form, the exhibitor must specify the 3 classes that his dog is entered in, that will count for the Triathlon, along with the score from the Triathlon Conformation class. The 3 classes are (1) the Open, Special or Veteran Stake in the AKC trial, or the Open, Field Champion or Veteran stake in the ASFA trial, or LGRA, (2) an obedience or a rally class and (3) a conformation class including the Altered class, a Veteran class or Best of Breed (stud dog, brood bitch, brace, team classes not eligible).
