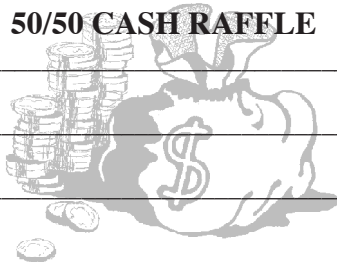

Health Committee Report

Spring is finally upon us and the BCOA Nationals are right around the corner. This year the seminar will be held on Thursday evening and our guest speaker is Dr. Steven Petersen. The following is a brief introduction of Dr. Petersen's background and his area of specialty:

Steven W. Petersen, DVM, is the owner and director of Veterinary Specialists of Nevada. Dr. Petersen is a Colorado native who attended both undergraduate and veterinary medical school at Colorado State University. He graduated from veterinary school in 1987 and did a two-year internship in emergency medicine and critical care at Alameda East Veterinary Hospital in Denver. Dr. Petersen completed a three-year small animal surgical residency program at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, where he was named "Resident of the Year" by the American College of Veterinary Clinicians in 1991. During his residency, Dr. Petersen's primary research interest was in antibiotics and ant microbial chemotherapy.

Dr. Petersen is board certified in small animal veterinary surgery and is a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons. His primary clinical interests are orthopedic surgery,

trauma surgery, neurosurgery, and reconstructive surgery for traumatic wounds. Within the realm of orthopedic surgery, his special interests include correction of pediatric injuries and growth deformities through distraction osteogenesis as well as general canine sports medicine including arthroscopic evaluation and treatment of joint and ligament injuries. He has a strong interest in teaching and has founded and directed several Doctor Internship programs. Dr. Petersen lectures locally and nationally to numerous veterinary associations and veterinary surgical organizations.

Outside of his hospital responsibilities, Dr. Petersen devotes his free time to his family, and enjoys skiing, windsurfing, cycling, and trail running with his dogs.

It is with much regret I report that Lou Avant has resigned from managing our on line BCOA Health Registry web site. Lou took on this project quite a few years ago with input from the membership that sprang from their desire to have a database where they could share health related information. It was a genuine labor of love for her and the fruits of her labor over the years have provided an invaluable service to our membership as a whole. §
