

Health Committee Report

all is here and plans are well under way for our National's health seminar and clinics to be held in Cincinnati, Ohio at the Kings Island Resort. This year we will be offering two health seminars.

Eddie Dzuik, OFA Director, will provide some very valuable insight into what is new with the OFA organization and the new CHIC data base registry program. Eddie has been a tremendous resource for me through his support and assistance with our health clinics over the last several years. He is a strong proponent of collecting empirical breed specific health information for breeders to utilize to improve their breeding programs and the longevity of the breed.

The other health seminar will be provided courtesy of Dr. Kate Meurs, PhD from Ohio State University. Dr. Meurs is very actively involved in many of the heart research grant projects for parent clubs through the Canine Health Foundation Donor Advised Funds. She will also be conducting our cardiac clinic during the day prior to the seminar. There will be no fee associated with either of these seminars for this year in celebration of our Centennial year thanks to the memberships generous donations to the Borzoi Health Committee!

Clinics will be offered at a substantially reduced rate as we encourage all of you to attend and celebrate the future of health and well being of all borzoi! Drs. Gary Nash and William Norelli have so very graciously volunteered to donate a day of their time to provide you with Microchip, DNA and thyroid clinics. We will also offer a CERF clinic, but at the time of this writing, I am still negotiating price reductions for both the ophthalmologist fee and the CERF registration fee. All clinic information, times, fees, specialist's names etc. will be posted to the Health Committee website which can be found from the BCOA Home Page pull down menu or can be accessed directly at: www.borzoihealth.org. In order to reduce the wait time at all of our clinics, the OFA, DNA & CERF forms will be made available and downloadable from our Health Committee website and included in the premium mailing. This will allow you to fill out the necessary forms well in advance when you have all the necessary information, like sire and dam registration numbers, at your fingertips. Our membership suggested this and we want you to know, we DO listen to your input and made these arrangements with OFA & CERF!

By the time you receive this publication of the BC, our health survey form should be loaded to our Health web site. This is our next step in collecting breed health data to be compiled into a statistical format to share with our membership and the CHF Donor Advised Fund coordinators. It will provide us with a look at what the top 4 health concerns are and if the order of any of these has changed or new areas of concern become more prevalent. We would like the membership to submit data on borzoi currently 10 years of age or younger as we want to assess the breed health status over the course of the last 10 years. The survey forms will also be available in your hospitality bags at the Nationals and we should also have them available at our Health Committee Information table.

The National Parent Club Canine Health Conference was held in St. Louis the weekend of September 17th thru the 19th. Gary Nash, DVM was our BCOA health representative and attended the weekend packed full of seminars. The AKC, CHF and Ralston Purina Corporation did an incredible job of coordinating the weekend's event covering a broad array of topics addressed by leading authorities in these areas. Topics covered ranged from Financing Canine Health Research, the CHIC program, Animal Insurance and Health Survey Implementation, through Genetic Testing, Genetic Diversity, Color Implications in Health, Reproduction, Cardiology Update, Cancer, Probiotics to Boost Immune System, Vaccination Update and Behavior and Training, just to name a few! The schedule of events to cover these topics and more ran from 6 in the morning to 10pm! Hardly time for Dr. Nash to catch his breath or use the men's room!! We plan to share the summaries of these seminars with all of vou at the Nationals and will also load this information to our health committee website for those of you not able to attend the Nationals.
