REGIONAL GOVERNOR'S REPORT

REGION 1 – Kari McCloskey

I want to thank the membership and the past and current board members for having me as a regional governor. I hope to continue to contribute in other ways to the BCOA in the future. The new regional governor for Region 1 will be Fred Vogel. I wish him well serving the region.

On September 9th, the Borzoi Club of Central New Jersey held their specialty with the Somerset Hills KC.

Borzoi Club of Delaware is supporting the entry at the Delaware Valley Hound Association show in December 9th, as well as supporting the entry at the Valley Forge KC shows on December 9th and 10th. The location is Oaks PA.

I received correspondence from BCDV and BCGNY, concerned about the change of dates for the 2024 National to be held in WA. Even though the shows are on the opposite coasts, these two clubs are very concerned about how if the national were to be held close to or overlapping their shows, that could impact their numbers. These two clubs are some of our smallest regional clubs and have held their shows over the same first weekend of May for as long as I have been involved in the breed. The first specialty I went to was BCGNY held in Ringwood NJ. Having the national held over Westminster KC will impact entries. When clubs force exhibitors to choose, both clubs lose out. More and more exhibitors are choosing to travel further to regional club events. I saw this with my own PVBC where we had an exhibitor from Alabama attend our specialty in VA and we had an owner from Connecticut come down to Maryland for our echo clinic. I am hoping a resolution is made, to not result in a decrease of entry at any of these shows.

REGION 5 – Kristina Terra

In preparation for the 2024 BCOA Specialty, I have worked closely with our Embroidery person, who has developed embroidered renditions of our two logos, we chose the merchandise that will be available with our logo, etc. I have had a couple of conversations with Gary Gideon that has done a fantastic job with the bonfire merchandise sales. Melissa Steck Hundley designed a new PNW-inspired Borzoi wind spinner that will be used as centerpieces for the Membership dinner and will be available for auction. The multitalented Rhonda Robbins created 12 individual one-of-a-kind renditions of the logo in faux stained-glass that will be used as centerpieces for the awards dinner. I had been in what seemed like constant contact with the Olympia Hotel manager, the vendor & Publicity chair Heather Lukashin, our webmaster Helen Lee, our RV parking manager Michelle Rowton, and our obedience chairs Sally Dalzell and Marie Agun, Marie Yoesel who is doing the field events, and many others. Heather Lukashin sourced at least three donors for our welcome bag and after my contact with Knopf Publishing, there is a strong possibility that they will sponsor our event, too. Unfortunately, many of the committee's efforts and time went to waste when, on November 3rd, we learned that we had lost our location. For the past week and a half, more than a dozen venues had been contacted, we had bids from 8 of them with possibly two more coming. Three site visits had been conducted, one by me and two by Hillary Tregillus in the Olympia, WA area. The membership might want to know that in the past, the club had been getting the meeting space for free (sometimes with substantial set-up and clean-up fees) because hotels used to give meeting spaces for groups that had a certain number of hotel nights (if that hotel night minimum is not met, then the club had to pay, as in Texas). The present-day reality is that it is nearly impossible to find a hotel with sufficiently large meeting space that would comp that space. We need a ballroom of 7800 square feet minimum, plus banquet room, seminar room, set-up room, auction room, grooming area, etc. Some of the quotes I had gotten for expo space (and we looked far and wide in both hotels, fairgrounds, covered arenas, expo centers, convention centers, etc.) ranged from \$1,200 to \$20,000 per DAY for the meeting space. I am cautiously optimistic that we found a space that will work for our needs but the contract is still in the works as is securing a local coursing field.

On the regional level, the Puget Sound Borzoi Club had its back-to-back specialties in September that were a great success – beautiful prizes, large ring, huge tent, and a salmon dinner.

- I received an email expressing concern regarding the proposed slate.
- I have been working with Joyce Law and Samantha Isaacs to complete the Top 5 Awards distribution. J. Law placed a rosette order with Hodges and S. Isaacs, at last notice, was working on certificates and mailings. I strongly believe we, as a board, need to evaluate this program. Lyn Hoflin Snyder can speak to us on the total cost which I believe will be upwards of \$850. We may need to seek out donations if we choose to continue this practice.
