DIRECTIONS TO TWIN TOWERS PARK

From South: I-75 to south of Dayton. Take I-675 (northeast) about 20 miles. Exit at Route 235 (Fairborn) and turn left on route 235 north. Go 0.5 miles and turn right at Yellow-Springs-Fairfield Road. Go 3.5 miles to the Park on the right.

From North/West: I-70 to east of Dayton, then exit on I-675 south. (ignore the route 235 exit off of I-70). On I-675 go south 3 miles and exit at Route 235 (Fairborn). Go right on route 235, north 0.5 miles and turn right at Yellow-Springs-Fairfield Road. Go 3.5 miles to the Park on the right.

From East: I-70 to west of Springfield, then exit on route 68 south (Xenia/Yellow Springs). On route 68 go south 6 miles, past Young's Dairy, and turn right at Yellow-Springs-Fairfield Road. Go 2 miles to the Park on the left.

The coursing field is west of the pavilion and building. Paddock will be south (at the back) of the building (not at the pavilion). Recommend you park on the south side of the parking lot. Please do not park on the grass (per Park rules).

• A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose on the field not competing in the course in progress. There will be a \$50 fine for those who do not pick up after their dogs.

• A battery operated, continuous loop lure machine, with backup equipment, will be used. Lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips. BCOA reserves the right to alter the course plan if required by weather and/or field conditions prior to or on the day of the trial, which may affect the usability of the field. Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee, will forfeit entry fee(s), and may be disciplined by the AKC.

Early acceptance of hounds for members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to published test hours.

ELIGIBILITY

All entries must be one year of age or older and individually registered with the American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry, or have an ILP or PAL number from the AKC. Spayed and neutered hounds are eligible. Monorchid & cryptorchid dogs are NOT eligible. Bitches in-season and lame hounds will be excused and entry fees refunded. Owners may NOT substitute for lame or in-season borzoi. Borzoi not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Entries will not be acknowledged by mail. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, unpaid or late entries will not be accepted.

TRIAL STAKES OFFERED

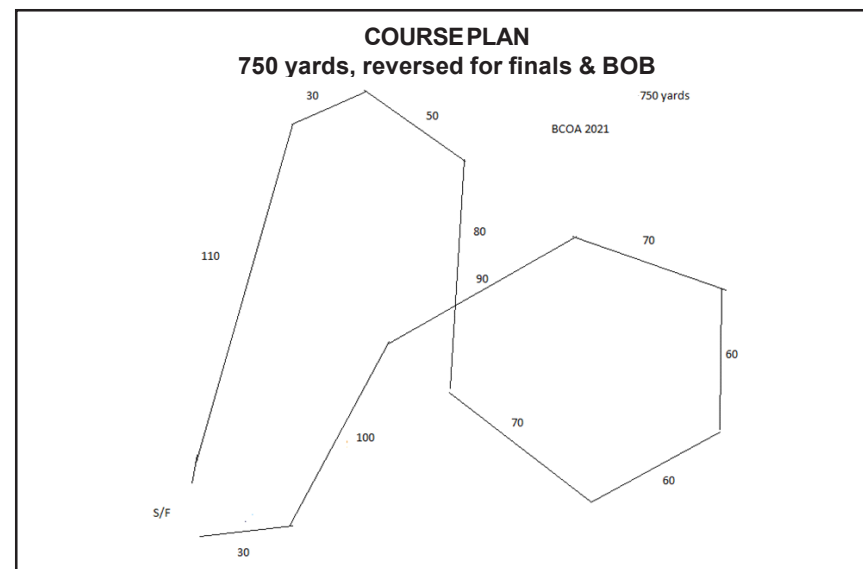
JUNIOR COURSER (JC) & QUALIFIED COURSER (QC) TESTS: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone shall receive one qualification from a judge, and second Qualification from a different judge at a separate event, stating that the hound complete a six hundred (600) yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. **Qualified Coursers** hound will run with another hound (Testing Hound). This certification is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. Additional rules and regulations may be found on the AKC website

OPEN: Open only to hounds of eligible breed, with no breed disqualifications, that hold an AKC QC certificate OR have run in the Open Stake prior to Jan. 1, 2010, OR have a Senior Coursers title OR have an ASFA or CKC field champion title. (a copy of this title must be attached to the entry form if the QC requirement is to be waived). Championship points are awarded from this stake. Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

OPEN VETERAN: Open only to hounds that are eligible to enter either Open or Specials Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake. Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

SPECIALS: Open only to hounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship title. LCX points may be awarded from this stake. Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

SINGLE: Open to all hounds of eligible breed, including those that are otherwise disqualified from entering the regular stakes (open, specials and veteran). Hounds entering in the singles stake may not also enter a regular stake at the same event. No championship or LCX points are awarded from this stake.
