King or Double Queen \$109 plus taxes and fees, per room, per night, which equates to \$123.88 inclusive per room, per night. Best Bred By Exhibitor will be for the winners of the Bred By Puppy and Bred By Adult classes Best Bred By Exhibitor Puppy WILL NOT compete for Best Puppy

#### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If at the end of the 90-day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

#### AWARDS OF MERIT

In addition to Select Dog and Select Bitch, the Regular Class Judge, may, at her discretion, present an Award of Merit Rosette to no more than ten (10) Dogs and/ or Bitches who have competed in the Best of Breed judging at the National Specialty. Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Bitch are not included in the ten Awards.

#### **ALTERED CLASS - SPECIAL ATTRACTION**

Open to any dog or bitch who has been spayed or neutered. Winner of this class will not compete for Winners or Best of Breed. All other dog show rules shall apply.

#### FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH PUPPY

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. It is a unisex competition. Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may not personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed may compete in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

Note: As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

**STUD DOGS:** For Stud Dogs and at least two and no more than four of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular or non-regular class or Best of Breed competition.

**BROOD BITCHES:** Same as Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**BRACE CLASS:** The two dogs, with at least one common owner, comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. Each dog must be entered in a regular or non-regular class or Best of Breed. Full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH BRACE must be so designated "Brace #1", Brace #2", etc.

**TEAM CLASS:** Same as Brace, except it will be for four dogs.

Entry fees for bitches in season will be refunded (minus \$5 administrative fee) if the Show Secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of first obedience or rally class.

Refer to the AKC Obedience or Rally Regulations for a complete definition of each class. Transfers are allowed in both obedience and rally, in accordance with AKC regulations. Transfers must be made to the on-site Show Secretary 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

Pee Wee & Toddler Class

### Saturday – June 8, 2024 during the Lunch Break

- For kids from 5 to under 9 years of age (accompanied by a parent or guardian)
- The Borzoi must be at least six (6) months of age to enter
- All dogs must have proper leash and collar
- No Entry Fee

Pee Wee Class is a pre-junior showmanship class for children who are at least age 5 and under age 9 years and Toddlers under 5 years of age on Saturday, June 8, 2024. This is not a competition but rather a fun and educational learning experience. Each child is accompanied into the ring by a responsible adult who stays with the child at all times; only one Pee Wee Handler and one adult will be in the ring at any



one time. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside the ring as well as ensure control inside the ring. A primary goal is safety and a positive experience for the children, so at the judge's discretion, the adult may be required to attach a second leash to the dog in the ring.

The Borzoi handled by the Pee Wee Handler must be at least six months of age and must be registered with the AKC. Bitches in season are not allowed to participate (eligible dogs may be substituted). Dogs must have a proper leash and collar. Before a Pee Wee participant will be allowed to enter the ring, his or her parent, grandparent or legal guardian must sign and return a "Release of Liability" form. Form is available from the chairperson (below) or on the BCOA website.

#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

#### NOVICE & OPEN CLASSES WILL NOT BE DIVIDED BY AGE.

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors who according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

After the judge has awarded the Best Junior Handler, the second place winner from the class that the Junior was awarded Best Junior Handler is to return to the ring to compete for Reserve Best Junior Handler.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, 919-233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. In addition, if the dog originally entered in Jr. Showmanship was an additional entry, and the dog being substituted is not otherwise entered in the show, the Junior Showmanship Only fee applies.

# AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a nontitling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.



All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned

or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner- Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then
  choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.

No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
