ELIGIBILITY

All entries must be one year of age or older and individually registered with the American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry, or have an ILP or PAL number from the AKC. Spayed and neutered Borzoi are eligible. Owners may substitute a borzoi which they own for a lame or in-season borzoi. Borzoi not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Entries will not be acknowledged by mail. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, unpaid or late entries will not be accepted.

Stakes offered:

Junior Courser (JC) Test: Open to all Borzoi at least 12 months of age running alone shall receive one qualification from a judge, and a second qualification from a different judge at a separate event, stating that the Borzoi completed a six hundred yard course with a minimum of four turns. The Borzoi must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

Qualified Courser (QC): Borzoi will run with another Borzoi

Open Stake: Open to all Borzoi that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or ASFA Certification Course certificate. This requirement will be waived for Borzoi that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Borzoi that have earned an AKC Field Championship title of record are not eligible to enter the Open Stake. Borzoi disqualified from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

Specials Stake: Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

Veteran Stake: Open to all Borzoi that are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title.

Single Stake: Open to all Borzoi of eligible breed, including those that are otherwise disqualified from entering the regular stakes (Open, Specials, and Veteran). Borzoi entering the singles stake may not also enter a regular stake at the same event. No championship or LCX points are awarded from this stake.

Non-Regular Stakes:

BREEDER STAKE: An entry shall consist of two hounds bred or co-bred by the same individual. Hounds must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran). Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Breeder Stake Award.

KENNEL STAKE: An entry shall consist of two hounds owned and living with the same person. Hounds must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran). Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Kennel Stake Award.

*Please Note: For Breeder & Kennel Stake: entries may consist of the identical pairing of dogs, but each dog may only be entered once in each stake. Hounds are named at the time of entry.

GENERATION STAKE: An entry shall consist of a stud dog OR a brood bitch and one dog produced by that dog. Both must be entered in one of the regular stakes (Open, Field Champion, Veteran) but need not be owned or bred by the same person. Each Stud Dog or Brood Bitch can only be paired with one chosen offspring; however an offspring can be paired with either one or both parents. Scores of the two hounds will be added and the highest combined score will be awarded the Generation Stake Award.

BENCH CHAMPION STAKE: For any hound eligible to enter a regular stake, that is an AKC, CKC, or ASFA-approved international show champion of record. A copy of the hound's championship certificate must accompany each Stake entry.

No award will be mailed.

Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee, will forfeit entry fee(s), and may be disciplined by the AKC. A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any Borzoi loose on the field not competing in the course in progress. There will be a \$50 fine for those who do not pick up after their dogs.

BCOA reserves the right to alter the course plan if required by weather and/or field conditions prior to or on the day of the trial, which may affect the usability of the field. A battery operated, continuous loop lure machine, with backup equipment, will be used. Lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.

Field Conditions: There is limited shade at the south end of this field, Please Plan to provide shade and water for your dogs
