## **Borzoi Genetics: The Hardy-Weinberg Equation and You**

#### Part 2 - The Borzoi and the Perfect Lawn

hen we think of lawns, we tend to think of perfection. Just the word "lawn" conjures up images of manicured, well-demarcated expanses of grass. Not just any grass but all the same kind of grass makes up a proper lawn.

Uniformity of height, make-up, and quality is the hallmark of a great lawn. No yellow spots or weeds allowed. Nothing to mar that green expanse of perfection. Such a lawn takes a lot of work and constant vigilance.

Breeders ofttimes express the goal to produce uniformity, to establish a recognizable "line." We often state that we seek to improve the breed as we strive for perfection in our dogs. We work toward that perfect rise at the loin, turn of stifle, neck set, ear, tail carriage, etc. We are working toward producing that perfect Borzoi; one that is readily recognized in the ring and field and one that produces consistent quality in its offspring. Like producing the vision of that perfect lawn, producing the vision of the perfect Borzoi is hard work and takes constant vigilance.

There are several ways to achieve this goal of uniformity. One way is to inbreed - father to daughter, mother to son, brother to sister, niece to uncle, nephew to aunt, cousin to cousin. Or one can line-breed - focusing on one dog or bitch and breeding dogs who have that desired individual in their pedigree together in the hopes of maintaining the qualities of that specific dog in your line. Or one can do assortative mating — breeding two Borzoi who are not related, selecting them based on the structure of the dog; like structure to like structure or like function to like function. Another way is to use a prepotent sire to help bring in the points of quality your line lacks. Each of these techniques can produce quality, uniform offspring if used with skill and knowledge.

But do we really want uniformity? Or, perhaps the question should be, exactly what is it that we want to be uniform? Do we want every single Borzoi to be exactly the same as the other? The same height, width, shape, color? When it comes to lawns, we would love to achieve this type of perfection. Is this the kind of perfection we want in our Borzoi? Do we want our Borzoi to be uniform in structure, function, and genetics?

What does the Hardy-Weinberg Principle say about the different breeding strategies; inbreeding, line breeding and assortative mating? And what does it mean for health?

What the Hardy-Weinberg Principle says about inbreeding, line breeding, and assortative mating is pretty much the same. If specific criteria are maintained, then none of the three breeding strategies will cause a reduction of genes. However, if those specific criteria are not maintained, all bets are off.

What are those criteria? Two of the criteria that are important to Borzoi breeders are large population size and the absence of selection. Borzoi do not have a large population. No breeder will breed without choosing which traits they want to maintain or avoid, so there is always selection with breeding. This means that year after year, with breeding choice after breeding choice, we lose genes.

There are two aspects of perfection that impact health: greater homozygosity and gene loss.

The whole point of breeding for perfection depends on increasing the homozygosity of the genes that control conformation, athleticism, and type. By doing that, a breeder can get consistent litters breeding after breeding because the only genes available are the ones for the type she has selected for. This was done in the creation of all breeds either through inbreeding or through assortative mating. Because of the selection that went into the formation of dog breeds, many of the genes they carry are already homozygous. Therefore, some traits are "fixed." Fixed traits cannot be altered or selected against because there are no other options unless some mutation occurs or a breeder brings in outside genes. Therefore, a breeder could not select for hairless Borzoi because a hairless gene does not exist.

When thinking only of perfection and creating consistent top winning dogs in ring or field having dogs homozygous for the genes you want them to have does not sound like a bad thing at all. The problem is, when using in-breeding or line-breeding one cannot control exactly which genes will become homozygous.

From a health perspective, there are two reasons homozygous genes can be problematic. First, too many fixed genes give you no choices. So if you suddenly realize that your dogs are now not only known for their beautiful flowing movement but also for losing their hair after the age of 5, there is no way to fix the problem without bringing in new blood and then having to select specifically against that hair loss gene for several generations, which may well send you back to the beginning of the process of setting type.

It is important to remind ourselves here that genetic health problems do not start out being easy to identify as problems. If they did, then there would be no health problems in pure-bred dogs because breeders would have made sure they did not exist in their lines. Health problems are insidious. One might have a health problem occur a time or two and then disappear for a time. It seems to have gone away. Perhaps, a breeder might think, it was not genetic after all. Or a sire/dam is identified with a health problem and the breeder holds his breath as the litters already on the ground mature. When they hear of no problems, they let out a sigh of relief thinking that they were lucky and avoided a problem. Then it shows up again, maybe once generations later. It may start out very mildly as something that can be explained away as something else. Perhaps the mild problem is noticed but ignored. Why worry about something that doesn't impact the dog?

However, health problems are stealthy. Remember, what you see or know about a dog or bitch is like sitting in the Titanic watching the icebergs float by. What you see may be beautiful and majestic, but it is what lies beneath that you should be aware of. Always, you should be taking measures to avoid getting too close or suddenly some unseen thing will unexpectedly rip your heart out. Yet, you were looking at it all along.

When breeding in a way that produces more homozygous genes all through the dogs in your line, without regard to which genes they are, the breeder must keep exhaustive records and be ruthless about removing dogs from the breeding program who have health issues. Failure to do so will cause the breeder to eventually double up on health problems, sometimes multiple times in a pedigree. Breeding as if a potential genetic health issue is either "one of those things" or purely of an environmental cause ("Oh he just slammed into the fence when he was running") is akin to plowing the Titanic through a pack of icebergs at full speed without lookouts. Your dogs may look really good, but they are a heartbreak waiting to happen.

This can happen with both inbreeding and line-breeding, though due to the nature of inbreeding, it has the potential to happen faster. Remember, as I discussed in "Borzoi Genetics: The Hardy-Weinberg Equation and You: Part 1 - The Borzoi and the Lawnmower" in the Fall 2016 edition of the *Aristocrat* these health problems may not occur frequently at first. The number of carriers has to become very high before you will start to see the disease in every litter.

But what about assortative mating? While this breeding strategy will also create an increase in the number of homozygous genes, which genes become homozygous tends to be more focused than when using inbreeding and line-breeding. Why is this? In classical assortative mating, unrelated dogs with similar characteristics are mated. The breeder identifies which characteristics are desired and breeds for that regardless of where the dog came from. This occurred in the formation of some very early breeds. Farmers needed dogs with a certain set of abilities to help handling the animals and protection from varmints, without regard to the way the dog looked or what the dog's parentage was. This produced the landraces that later became breeds like the Border Collie and the Malinois. The benefit of this type of breeding is that genes for health are usually not the ones that become more homozygous. Therefore, the overall genetics maintain more heterozygosity.

Unfortunately, because of the small population size of the Borzoi, there is a good possibility that any breeding done is a line-breeding. This is even true if you import a dog from outside the country. Based on the diversity analysis done on Borzoi by UC Davis, there are some Borzoi that are genetically different from the majority, but you need a tool such as that provided by Better Bred to help you find them.

The second reason homozygous genes are problematic for health

is the nature of inheritance. The commonly accepted view is that most disease genes are recessive in nature. The idea here is that dominantly inherited genetic disease would be quickly identified as a problem by breeders and eliminated. But genetic disease, even dominantly inherited genetic disease can still hide from a breeder's concern for quite a while before an alarm can be raised. Look at the Doberman Pinscher. The breed is plagued with dilated cardiomyopathy (DCM). There are various estimates of the prevalence of this disease that hover at approximately 50%. Both genes known to be implicated in the cause of Doberman DCM are dominantly inherited. That means that if a dog with this condition is bred, anywhere between one half to all of his/her off-spring will be affected depending on whether the affected parent is heterozygous or homozygous for the disease gene.

Remember, Doberman breeders are just like Borzoi breeders. They are not somehow less caring, more secretive, or inept than Borzoi breeders. The rules that govern the breeding decisions they make are the same ones that govern the decisions Borzoi breeders make. So how did a problem as severe as Doberman DCM become so common? First, lack of acknowledgement of the problem. It is very easy to assume a problem is not genetic. Our minds naturally tell us stories to help us cope with painful loss. This is not a problem unless we allow our stories to hide from ourselves the fact that a death may well have a genetic basis. This is an even greater risk when the death or illness is either in or connected to a dog who is the pinnacle of one's breeding program.

So a dominantly inherited cause of DCM occurs occasionally in a breed. Because it occurs sporadically across bloodlines, it seems like "just one of those things," something that is not genetic at all. People make excuses and assumptions to explain the problem away and continue breeding as normal, without thinking the problem could be genetic. Some people are inbreeding or line-breeding and, because of that, the problem becomes either more common or less common in their lines, depending on happenstance or the rigorous selection applied by the breeder.

Then a magnificent animal appears on the scene. He is exquisite. He is consistently recognized in the show ring. His offspring are stamped with the mark of his quality. Many breeders are drawn to this dog because of his ability to produce quality offspring with a variety of bitches. He is bred often. At the age of seven, he is diagnosed with DCM. By this time, his offspring and grand offspring are spread through many bloodlines, and because of the quality he has stamped his get with, those dogs are sought after for breeding. In 10 years, there is hardly a dog who does not go back to this popular sire. Unfortunately, a lot of those dogs will have the gene for DCM, and, because it is a dominantly inherited gene, dogs are dying.

This is where the popular sire comes in with regards to health. The breeding strategies we use can lead to genetic disease in our dogs, but the fastest way to make a disease that is not on anyone's radar become a sudden and severe problem is through

a popular sire. The disease does not have to be dominantly inherited for this to occur. In fact, if the disease is recessive then the problem is more insidious. The sire can live a long and healthy life if he is a carrier; so can his offspring, as can his grand offspring. But a certain percentage of these dogs will also be carriers like their famous ancestor and, when bred, they will pass it on. If the disease is rare in the breed, the problem will not appear until the popular sire starts showing up on both sides of the pedigree. And when pedigrees have the popular sire within them multiple times on both sides, the risk of disease from a once rare health problem becomes far more commonplace.

The allure of a popular sire is obvious. We have all had the experience of discovering that every single Borzoi that catches our eye was sired by a certain dog. But we must be careful when others are drawn to the same animal. Geneticists tell us that every single dog carries about 5 deleterious genes. Many of these may well be extremely rare, others may be more common. But should a dog become widely used, not only will those deleterious genes become much more common breed wide, but we will lose valuable genes from other sires that are ignored. Popular sires give us the double whammy of increased homozygosity of genes and gene loss, both of which cause future problems for breed health.

So the question is, what kind of perfection are you working toward in your breeding program. Looks? Performance? Or are you working toward the whole Borzoi, one that can fulfill its function, measure up to the standard, has a stable, appropriate

temperament for the breed, and is vital and healthy into the second decade of life?

As Dr. Jerold Bell states frequently, you cannot get health without selecting for it. But health problems are hidden from view, so how does one select for health? Just as with the perfect lawn, you cannot achieve that perfection without the help of others: from the people who produce the type of grass that is ideal for your soil and climate, to the manufacturers of products that will keep your lawn at its peak of health, to the products used to keep that yard manicured with that ideal look. The same is true with health. Breeders cannot successfully select for health without detailed information from other breeders. The information breeders need to know is not just the health information of the sire and dam, but as many dogs in their pedigrees as possible. And when it comes to recessive genes, knowing about the health of the siblings of the dogs in the pedigree is important as well. The more complete the information a breeder has, the more informed her choices will be as she works to keep from doubling up on health issues. We are in this together. We cannot succeed without each other.

So when working toward your goal of perfection there are questions that must be kept in mind:

How am I selecting for health? How am I working to preserve the long term health of our breed? How am I helping my fellow breeders do this successfully? §

## Live-Stream videos of the national!

The 2021 Ohio National is fast approaching and in the final stages of planning. This year's COVID climate is forcing the BCOA Board and the National Specialty Committee to rethink how to put on a successful show. This is to inform you of a Live-Stream offer to those that may or may not be present in Ohio.

There's a good assumption some folks won't be comfortable traveling this year and are looking for a way to view the classes as they're being judged and beyond the close of the show. This is not only our community of BCOA members and non-members who own, breed and show Borzoi but will include novices looking to learn, other breed owners and potential Borzoi judges.

We began looking for the best way to represent the breed to those outside of our Borzoi family. In the past, there have been attendees on site live-streaming the events to the Borzoi National Exchange group Facebook page for all to see. This free offer has been appreciated by BCOA members and non-members alike. They were live-streamed directly from iPhones and/or iPads.

Although this was a great way to view the show and weighing the advantages / disadvantages of each option, the Board has decided to utilize a professional service (TNG Digital Media Services, Inc. dba Show Dog Video Pros) to bring the show to our homes or location. There will also be a number of large screen TVs that people can watch on site. This includes monitors to review your dog from a class for possible purchase. It does come with a caveat:

- This will only be for conformation, sweeps and futurity in-ring classes. Companion and performance classes may continue to be individual live streamed.
- The cost is \$40 for a show pass and then you can watch the entire show and review it through Jan. 1, 2022.
- There will also be many options to buy the edited video, either just your class, per day or the whole show. Prices for those videos range from approximately \$40 to \$200 for the whole package. Specifics will be on the videographer's web site.
- You will be able to film your own dog on your tablet or whatever you have (no tripods, etc.) but not the whole class. You can't stream your video to Facebook, etc. You can forward your video to family and friends when the class is completed.
- This service is being provided at no cost to BCOA and no member has connections to Show Dog Video Pros.

Caryl Dumaine is the 2021 National Vendor Chair who is assigned to work with the videographer.

## **ShowDogVideoPros**website

#### Terms:

The professional video services and live streaming at this show are governed by an exclusive video contract with the Club. No other commercial video recording, video recording from a tripod, monopod or other supported camera/device, or any video recording or streaming of large parts or whole classes shall be permitted. The contract terms permit individuals to record small bits of video of their own dogs only, and using handheld devices only (e.g. phone, tablet or small camcorder). Individuals may post recorded videos of their own dogs to social media (Facebook, YouTube, etc). However, during show hours LIVE Broadcast Streaming to social media (e.g., Facebook Live) is not permitted. Submission of an entry form and/or physical presence on the show grounds shall constitute both implied and real consent for both the handler and the dog to be professionally video recorded and streamed live only by the professional video services as contracted by the Club for this show.

All rights to video record and live stream or otherwise exploit this event and/or the persons or animals participating in it, including the names, likenesses and biographical matter of dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the event shall belong solely to the show giving Club and/or the American Kennel Club, Inc. No spectator, participant, owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall make commercial use of any video recordings of any person or animal participating in this event without prior written approval from the Club. This event may not be broadcast to social media (e.g. Facebook Live, etc) without prior written approval from the Club.

#### I. General

#### **Borzoi Registrations**

In 1958, Borzoi were ranked 76th out of 105 breeds with 115 Borzoi registered (down from 162 Borzoi registered in 1957).

#### **Point Scales**

Starting in May 1958, the country was divided into five regions: East/North, South/West, the Pacific Northwest (WA OR ID MT UT WY NE ND SD), California and Hawaii. For all regions, except for California, the points for Borzoi were set at the minimum: 2 dogs or 2 bitches for 1 point. 3 dogs or 3 bitches for 2 points. 4 dogs or 4 bitches for 3 points. 5 dogs or 5 bitches for 4 points. 6 dogs or 6 bitches for 5 points. For California, numbers were increased for bitches, so it took 5 bitches for 3 points, 7 bitches for 4 points and 9 bitches for 5 points.

Per a BCOA report, in 1958, Borzoi were eligible to compete in 438 shows and were entered in 179 shows. Borzoi won Group 1 five times, Group 2 six times, Group 3 sixteen times, Group 4 eight times.

Per an AKC report, for 1958, Borzoi shown were ranked 54th out of 112 breeds, with 575 entries. In 1958 there were 440 all-breed shows and 337 specialties, compared to 1957 which had 432 all-breed shows and 332 specialties. Both 1958 and 1957 had 290 breed clubs that considered their breed classes at the all-breed shows, as their specialties. This included the three Borzoi clubs, BCOA, MBC and BCOC. Total number of all breeds of dogs entered in 1958 were 272,872 compared to 256,381 total dogs entered in 1957. 81% of shows were un-benched in 1958. 78% of shows were un-benched in 1957.


The all-breed show with the largest entry in 1958 was the Westminster kennel club show with 2008 entries. Next was the International Kennel Club of Chicago show with 2006 entries, followed by these shows Harbor Cities CA, Long Beach CA, Santa Barbara CA, Westchester NY, Santa Ana Valley CA, Golden Gate CA, Philadelphia PA, Heart of America Kansas City MO and San Fernando CA.



# IV News (litters, Borzoi purchased, awards, club news)

The Annual BCOA Award winners for 1958 were: Best of Breed to Ch. Vigow of Romanoff III. Owner Miss Lena Tamboer. Best Opposite Sex to Ch. Melisande of Rancho Gabriel. Owner Mrs. Isabell V. Walton. Best American Bred to Trezor Alupka. Owner Dr Charles R. Conally. (The awards were presented to the winners at the BCOA membership meeting in February 1959).

Mrs. Denton, secretary-treasurer of BCOA, received a letter, Sept 1958, from Ralph Bienfang, PhD of the University of Oklahoma, Norman Oklahoma, asked for a the address of a breeder of chocolate colored Borzoi. Mrs. Denton sent him the list of all BCOA member-breeders.

Mrs. Lydia Suchoff, a new BCOA member, owns two bitches; one bred by Karl Schmid of Adams and Baron's Wood bloodlines and the other is a Romanoff bitch, bred by Louis Murr.

Robert Parker, a new BCOA member, owns a promising male puppy from a litter bred by A K Robinson, sired by Denton's Prince Nicholas out of Sniezhinka of Romanoff.

The Borzoi Club of Northern California was approved to hold shows by the AKC in 1958. The club's first specialty show is scheduled to be held October 25, 1959 in conjunction with the Sacramento kennel club all-breed show. The club members elected in March 1958: president Mrs. Phydelma Gillette; vicepresident Mrs. Dixie Bilodeau; secretary -treasurer Mrs. Phyllis Johnson; board of directors Mrs. Carla Alioshin Mrs. G. Clifford Potter, Mrs. Anne Goschke and Dimitri Alioshin. Awards were given to Ch. Yermak's Platon, owned by Mr. and Mrs. Goschke, winner of the Rancho Gabriel Champion's Cup that is awarded on the the point system. Ch. Yermak's Rurick, owned by Mr. and Mrs. Sidney Cox, received the trophy for the most outstanding male of the year. The trophy for the most outstanding bitch of the year went to Ch. Tatiana of Alpine, bred and owned by Mrs. Potter, who also won the trophy for greatest number of points during the year from the Bred By Exhibitor class. (Tatiana was later sold to Mrs. Charlotte Acciavatti of Connecticut.) Marion Woodcock judged the second sanctioned match of the Borzoi Club of Northern California held in Sacramento October 19, 1958. She awarded Best in Match to 14 month old Chuda of Alpine owned by Carla Alioshin and Mrs. G. Cliford Potter (Alpine), and BOS to Patrikevna of Alpine owned by Mr. and Mrs. J. L. Johnson.

Ch Obverozevat Laska of Alpine. Owners Lyle & Phydelma Gillette, handled by Phydelma, won BOB and Best Local Dog in Show at the Borzoi Club of California Specialty and Group 4. This was her 6th group placement. She was also BOB at the 1958

BCOC specialty in June, and went BOS to Ch. Black Falcon of Twin Elms at Westminster 1958. She was sired by Aragan of Alpine CD out of Ch. Uda Adams, bred by Mrs. Potter. Born at Rancho Gabfield, September 1958, were 8 pups all white with gold markings, sired by Hollister of Rancho Gabriel x Ch. Garsova Ivanova of Alpine.

Owners Dimitri and Carla Alioshin (Yermak Borzoi) reported the death from cancer of Yermak of Marbob, white with blue markings. January 20, 1950 – June 19, 1958, by Ch. Damon of Alpine x Annika of Twin Elms, breeder Mrs. Mariel L. Whitney.

Borzoi Club of California members Marge and Sidney Cox have moved from northern California to Torrance, California, to have a large yard for their 3 Borzoi. Their Am Ch. Yermak's Rurick, call name "Ricky," won 3 CC in Mexico to earn the Mexican Champion title. He is the first Borzoi in recent years to earn titles in two countries. Their Ch. Alta of Alpine is in the Greek Ballet "Giselle." She appears in the hunting scene of the First Act with Igor Youskeirtch and Alicia Alonzo.

From the June 1958 letter written by Isabell V Walton, El Monte CA, to Erma Denton: "I have not bred a litter since a year and half ago, and that is the one where all ten of eleven were black and white ... and very heavily marked. I have located a very lovely puppy which I may submit to your friend, very similar breeding as my own, in fact a half brother to my Ch. Melisande of Rancho Gabriel ...(The puppy) is almost 11 months old, white with only pale gold head markings and the one side body marking...The dam is Ch. Obvorozevat Laska of Alpine ... sire Ch. Yermak's Rurick ... He has been priced to me at \$250 ....I plan to breed a litter within the next few months but I too am curtained for space and at present I have 13 Borzoi and one dane ....I did dispose of all of my danes since my son re-enlisted in the Army ...I lost my old Ch. Llebasi's Rushan Vodka, he was my first love ... He was by Volk O'Baronswood and Ch. Bellona of Rydens (an English import owned by Marion Woocock). Vodka was lovely, very refined dog, and many judges told me, he would have made a beautiful bitch. When I returned home from Arizona three years ago, I brought back only Vodka and Bumps, a definite pet, pure bred, but not showable. That was all that was alive out of the five that I took to Arizona. The other three including Volk, bled to death from the extreme summer heat. So I started over and I purchased Ch. Golupka of Alpine, from Dorothy Harris, and I have bred this one black and white litter. I had previously purchased a pup of the same identical breeding as my Golupka-Gotchina litter\*, in January 1956, and she is now 2 ½, so I will breed her at her next season. I then acquired my now Ch. Melisande of Rancho Gabriel, but she had been bred at 13 months, which I feel is entirely too young, in very poor condition. I bought her when her puppies were just 3 weeks old and will breed her next year. I want to give her a chance to get well back up on her feet, and with two years between litters, I think I should do it ... J do hope this pup will interest your customer as I think he fits his specifications much nearer than anything I have, and it is very

nearly the same breeding. Ch. Uda Adams is the grandmother of my litter, Ch. Atamen of Alpine the grandsire on the fathers side, Uda being on the mothers side, Ch. Midfyns Boya imported from Denmark is back of both sides .." (\*Editor's note: This was likely a reference to a litter sired by Ch. Gotchina of Grador H276810, stud book 4-56, out of Ch. Golupka of Alpine H277857, stud book 4-56, breeder Isabell Walton.)

Breeder/owner Isabell Walton reported that her Llebasi's Abigail, a self red female with very little white, died in her sleep June 17, 1958. She was by Ch. Volk O'Baron's Wood x Rona of Ashtonia. Also that Isabell's Llebasis Rushan Vodka, a self blue male died May 1958. He was also sired by Isabell's Ch. Volka O'Baron's Wood.

Borzoi owners were honored at the dinner of the Orange Empire club. Mrs. Isabell Walton (Llebasi) received a bronze medal for Best of Breed wins of her Ch. Melisande of Rancho Gabriel. William and Marion Woodcock (Suntan) received two bronze medals for Best of Breed wins by Ch. Hasi Murat of Suntan and Mariska of Suntan. James and Betty Forry (Oakshade) got a gold medal in honor of their new champion Taras Bulba of Suntan. Their daughter, June Forry, got a bronze medal for the Best of Breed win of her Ch. Zonazo Perchinoff CD at the 1957 California club's specialty.

James and Betty Forry, of Topanga, CA, earned a Companion Dog title on their fourth Borzoi, Oakshade's Dona Junia CD.

At the annual meeting of the Mid-West Borzoi Club, March 29, 1958, the following officers were elected: president Henry Mackh, Wayne, IL; first vice-president Mrs. Harriet Lindsay, Roanoke, IN; second vice-president Mrs. Edna Hillgamyer, East St Louis, IL; secretary Mrs. Villa Smith, Manchester, MO; directors Mrs. Charlotte Machkh, Wayne, IL; Charles Miller, Deerfield IL; Mrs. Mabel Millichip, Holden, MO; Chester J. Clark, Glen Arbor, MI; and Ed Hillgamyer, East St Louis, IL. Henry Mackh was presented with an Award of Merit for his efforts in behalf of the Mid-West Borzoi Club

Mrs. John (Harriet) Lindsay reported the deaths of two of her Borzoi, Sophia, and Tiranka of Colinwood, who were shot by hunters.

One of Henry and Charlotte Mackh's Borzoi is in the Mercury Motor ad. The Mackhs of Wayne, Illinois have puppies sired by their Ch. Dark Star of Sleeping Bear out of Ch. Shalimar of Sleeping Bear.

Erma Denton reported that the Everharts were absent from the BCOA specialty because of an illness (probably distemper) that swept through their kennel, killing 6 of their Borzoi in April 1958. They were littermates Ramadan Rich, a male, breeder Mrs. Mary M. Taviner, white with sable markings, sired by Gay Cavalier of Yadasar out of Ch. Ivanda of Yadasar, born May 3, 1955, and his sister Ramadan Nur Jehan white with gold markings. Littermates

Trezor Ataman, a male. Owner Earl Hendrickson, and females Trezor Annia and Trezor Amalei, breeder/owner Russell Everhart, born November 23,

1956, sired by Ramadan Righ out of Firebird of Malora. Also died was Trezor Borgia, a female, sired by Winjones Janda out of Ramadan Koraleva Chevry born December 17, 1956, breeder/owner Russell Everhart.

September 14, Iris Miller and Ch. Millrock's Bronze of Malora scored 194 in Novice B. at the Sioux City, Iowa show. At the Omaha show, he earned his second obedience leg and won Best of Breed.

The 5 year old Solo Barnaigh from Mrs. McNeil's kennel in Glasgow, Scotland was imported in June to James Barr's Sunbarr kennel in Thiensville, Wisconsin. Solo Barnaigh whelped 4 males and 5 females, December 29, 1958, sired by Tobolzkoi Krasnoje Selo; breeder James Barr.

Ch Czarina HHF of Gwejon Am/Can CD, had a litter of two males, both white with sable markings, on August 29, 1958. They were sired by Barasha Hensey Hobby Farm of Gwejon, also owned by breeder Gwen Pinette (Gwejon). Czarina completed her American Companion Dog title in 1957 with scores of 196, 196.5 and 192 in Novice A, earning her a *Dog World* Award of Distinction. In May 1958, she completed her Canadian CD with scores of 197.5, 198.5 and 199.5 in Novice B. Czarina was second high in trial at all 3 trials in Canada. She also was awarded a High Combined trophy for having the highest combined scores for the last 2 trials (same club) out of 90 dogs. Czarina was owner handled to her Championship, finishing in February 1958 at Westminster. She won Best of Winners every time, except for one Reserve. Czarina appeared in the New England Dog Food Company's advertising. (The HHF in her name is for Hensey Hobby Farm).

Valdaihills Glad Tidings, breeder/owner Mr. & Mrs. Wildish, Nov 22, 1949 – June 1958, by Ch. Eglon of Rydens x Belle of Valdaihills.

Imported to Canada from England, Prunella of Fortrouge. Imported during 1958 to the USA was Nikitoyo of Malines from England and Grozny Gay Girl from England.

The female Barinoff Promise True was purchased in 1958 by Mary Taviner from breeder M. G. Sarson, a famous canine portrait painter in England. The English import comes from Marinsky and Mazeppa bloodlines. Mary Taviner plans to have her handled in the show ring by Carla Alioshin in California.

Mrs. J. F. McCartey of Fremont Nebraska has a male sired by Barinoff Ambassador out of Lucky Lady of Barnaigh. She also has a bitch, Countessa of Malora, from Winjones and Barnaigh bloodlines, that she plans to breed to Ch. Millrock's Bronze of Malora.

For 1958, out of 115 Borzoi registered, 44 of these were from Haljean bitches: Haljeans's Starlight of Malora 8 pups, Haljeans's Moonlight of Malora 9 pups, Haljeans's Mystery 12 pups (all black and white), Haljeans's Tasha 10 pups, Haljeans's Gypsy 5 pups.

Born June, 1958, 5 males, 7 bitches, by Dark Hazard of Malora x Haljean's Mystery, Mrs. Russell T (Jeannette) Whisler.

Int. Ch. Amurat von Merdody, imported from Germany by Clarence R. DeCraene Sr., sired his first American litter with Haljean's Moonlight of Malora. The 9 pups are heavily marked with darkish brown and tan shades on white.

Mrs. Jeannette Whisler (Haljean) sold 2 young Borzoi to the ambassador from Pakistan.

Ch Vigow of Romanoff II sired 2 males and 5 females, no dam listed, breeder Louis Murr (Romanoff).

The Ray De Craene's Dutch bitch produced 8 boys and a girl with Nellie Wood Hilsmier's Ch. Black Falcon of Twin Elms.

The Allisons of Delaware NJ have a litter of 8 sired by Dentons Prince Nicholas out of their Sylvia, 5 females and 3 males.

Mrs. Jean Goshorn has a litter of one black and white male, and 2 fawn and white females, that are a blend of Barnaigh, Mogedo, Von Bergland bloodlines with a little Romanoff way back.

Born April 4, 1958, 4 males and 1 female by Ch. Nicholas Siberius x Ch. Lisa Denton, breeder Erma Denton.

In the summer 1958, Erma Denton and her husband Lawrence, visited Edinburgh and attended a dog show, where she found Borzoi on the bench listed not under Borzoi, but under "Any Variety Hound." She saw Tolstoy of Barnaigh (by Ch. Reyas Romancer x Olga of Barnaigh) with owners Mr. & Mrs. McNeil. Katherine McNeil has been a breeder of Borzoi for many years, and is also a judge. While in London, Erma Denton visited with Fred Curnow and his wife who started the Woodcourt kennel in 1931, with two Addlestone Borzoi. Mr. Curnow is a judge, and will be coming to the USA to judge in October. Erma Denton also visited with Mrs. F. W. George, the secretary of the English Borzoi club, who has been active in the breed since 1928, using the kennel name Tangmere.

The white Borzoi reclining on the glossy floor in the Johnson Wax ad, belongs to Bernard D'Esson of New York City.

Arnold J. Brock died Feb 4, 1958. He joined BCOA in 1945, was president in 1955 and 1956, on the board of governors 1957, and was a judge.

Mrs. Carama Chantler, Iskra kennel Shreveport LA, passed

away September 10, 1958. She got her first Borzoi in 1921, Ch. Princess Troubetskoy (Blistai F. R. x Austin's Kasa). Princess was born in 1918, a



descendent of Bistri of Perchina. Carama Chantler owned Ch. Ivanovitch of Glenwild, who won the Sporting Group (hounds were shown in that group in those days) 9 times out of 10 shows, and won best in show all breed twice. She owned Ch. Major B, a significant sire. Carma Chantler imported Brynzga of Bransgore from Mrs. Ginsgold. She was a long time member of BCOA, having joined the club when it was known as the Russian Wolfhound Club of America. She was a founder of the Louisiana kennel club and served on that club's board.

Harriet Crane's 6 month old puppy, Denton's Lyka, won the Puppy Hound group at the Twin Brooks club's show. A month later, he was killed in an accident. The two Borzoi in the fashion pictures in the September 2, 1958 issue of Look magazine, are Harriet Crane's Andea Alexis and Mrs. Dusenbury's Ch. Nicholas Siberius.

From the March 1958 letter from Stedman Shumway Hanks, "Gatchina kennels were started about 1613, the Perchino kennels 1787, the Woronzoa kennels started about 1866. These three famous kennels in Russia were responsible for the excellent kennels that were later established in Germany and in Belgium (Du Zwaenhoek kennels) but, unfortunately, none of these kennels exist today. It is interesting to know that most of the Borzoi in Seacroft kennels (established in 1889; the Borzoi arrived in 1890 or 1891), came from the Gatchina kennels and breeders associated with these Imperial Kennels of the Czar. Then shortly after 1903, many of the Borzoi in the famous O'Valley Farm kennels came from the Perchino Kennels. These O'Valley Farm Borzoi were bred with many of the Seacroft Borzoi. Today, only the Seacroft kennels exist."

While Benson Saler was stationed in Germany, he and his wife Joyce visited the Von Bergland kennel. They purchased the 3 year old Fedja von Bergland. The red male with white markings was born October 27, 1954. He was sired by Yukon von Bergland out of Adina Her-Jaegers-Meute, bred by Mrs. Hanna Mueller. Mr. and Mrs. Saler attended dogs shows in Germany and Austria. They reported back to the BCOA Aristocrat editor, Gwen Pinette, that they saw two different styles of Borzoi. In south Germany and Austria, the Borzoi shown tended to be smaller and lighter boned than the Borzoi the Salers had seen in the USA. At shows in northern Germany, the Borzoi, some from Holland, were similar to the USA Borzoi. Benson also reported that the judges spent a lot of time counting every tooth. Benson and Joyce attended racing meets, and described how a "toy rabbit" was pulled around the course by a string tied to a bicycle wheel. A man peddled the bicycle, with the wheel not touching the ground, so that the revolving wheel wound the string.

Mrs. Dykstra of Springfield MA, purchased a 5 month old gold bitch with silver shadings and plans to show her in breed and obedience.

Mrs. Audrey Laurie of Quebec (aka Audrey Benbow, Sirhan - pictured)) has a new Borzoi puppy, white with silver, who will be shown in breed and obedience. Mrs. Laurie also owns poodles and an imported Scottish Deerhound who has many group placements in Canada and the USA.



The top Borzoi in Canada for 1958 is Mrs. Martinson's Can Ch. Kuban Kuzma CD who has two all-breed Best In Show wins. He was sired by Curio of Fortrouge out of Kuban's Mantilla of Yof, born in 1953, bred by Mrs. U. Reed in England and imported to Canada at 5 months of age.


# V. BCOA Board minutes (summaries), BCOA membership

February 11 board meeting in New York City, after the Westminster show. The results of the 1958 election were President Weldon J. McCluskey, First Vice-President Clarence R. Decraene Sr., Second Vice-President Russell Everhart, Secretary-Treasurer Mrs. Erma Denton, AKC Delegate Chester Adee. Board of Governors Mrs. Grace Dusenbury, Mrs. Terry DeCraene, and Miss Harriet Crane. Colonel Stedman Hanks was selected by the Board members, to replace the deceased Mr. Brock. Colonel Hanks is the son of the late Charles Stedman Hanks, the first American to import Borzoi directly from Russia. Colonel Hanks kept his father's kennel name, Seacroft. The following new members were approved: Mr. & Mrs. Lyle Gillette of Santa Clara, CA; Miss Constance Caunt of Windsor, Ontario; Canada, Mrs. Lydia Suchoff of Shewsbury, NJ; Miss Iris Miller of Omaha, NE; and Robert Parker of New York City. The current BCOA membership is 78, including two Life Members.

BCOA membership meeting after the specialty, May 24, with 15 members present. Mr. Woodley resigned as the editor of the BCOA newsletter, and was replaced with Mrs. Raymond (Terry) DeCraene, Jr. The following new members were approved: Mrs. Charles Endicott of Grosse Point, MI; John H. Gamber of Harrisburg, PA; Burton Axe of Philadelphia, PA; Mr. & Mrs. Henry (Elizabeth) Allison of Delaware, NJ. The *Dog World* award was presented to Mrs. Erma Denton. Miss Lena Tamboer moved to hold the 1959 specialty with the Monmouth County club show, seconded by Clarence DeCraene Jr., motion passed. Members made suggestions as to judges for next year's show, to the Bench Show committee (Weldon McCluskey, Mrs. & Mrs. Ray DeCraene). Members also discussed trophies to be offered.

BCOA board meeting, September 6 after the judging of Borzoi at the Somerset Hills show. Present were Weldon J. McCluskey, Harriet Crane, Grace Dusenbury, Mrs. Terry DeCraene Jr., Chester Adee and Clarence R. DeCraene Sr. Mrs. Denton was

not present due to the illness of her dogs, but had sent the pins and medals given to her from the English Borzoi Club to be given out at a BCOA specialty. Mr.



Tamboer Borzoi; and Mrs. Harriet Strickland of Harrisburg, PA.

BCOA meeting, Dec 12, 1958 at the offices of the AKC in New York City. Present were president Weldon J. McCluskey, Colonel Stedman Hanks, Chester Adee, Miss Harriet Crane, Mrs. Raymond (Terry) DeCraene Jr., Clarence R. DeCreane Sr., and Mrs. Erma Denton. It was reported that 11 new members were added during 1958. The Aristocrat was published once, in March 1958 by William Woodley. The Borzoi column, written by Mrs. Erma Denton, was published in each monthly issue of the AKC Gazette. The board held four meetings during 1958. There have been 2 membership meetings, February 11 and September 6. Mrs. Terry DeCraene reported that the Bench Show Committee wishes to divide the Puppy classes into two age groups and add Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes. AKC approval had been received to consider the Borzoi classes of the Monmouth County kennel club show to be held at Runson, NJ on May 23, 1959 as our specialty show. Lifetime membership was approved for Colonel Stedman Shumway Hanks. The following new members were approved: Miss Catherine Dean, handler of the Wolfschmidt Borzoi of New York City; Mrs. Mary Gamber of Harrisburg, PA, who has a puppy from the Allisos' Sylvia sired by Denton's Prince Nicholas; and Nathaniel Steinberg of Waterville, ME. Col Hanks, Bernard D'Essen and Mr. Adee did not present a report on specialty trophies, as their committee needs more time. Mr. Adee, chairman of the Revisions Committee reported that the changes to the Constitution and By-Laws were not accepted by the AKC, and would have to be revised again. Mrs. John (Gwen) Pinette was approved to edit the club newsletter, *The Aristocrat*. The next Aristocrat will be published in January 1959. Mr. Clarence DeCraene Sr. moved that the 1959 annual awards be the same as those offered in 1958 with the addition of the Brock Memorial Trophy offered by Mr. and Mrs. Raymond DeCraene; motion was seconded and passed. Mrs. Denton requested that Mrs. Ray DeCraene send her the trophy offer in writing so she may present it to the AKC for approval. Miss Crane read the nominating committee report. The committee recommended that the new Constitution provide for at least three and possible four vice-presidents, so it will be possible to have a representative from both the Mid-West and the two California clubs. Also recommended that the names of the representative of the Mid-West and California clubs be submitted by those clubs' members. §
