TRY IT! YOU'LL LIKE IT!

ello BCOA members and Borzoi owners. My wife Melissa and I are the Obedience and Rally chairpersons for the 2023 National Specialty in Virginia Beach, VA. We would like to encourage Borzoi handlers to consider training with your dogs and entering one or more obedience and rally classes at the specialty.

It has been said many times that a Borzoi is not very trainable to compete in Obedience or Rally. This common misconception may even deter Borzoi owners from trying to work with their dog. There have been many examples, however, of handlers that have demonstrated that a Borzoi makes a wonderful companion sport dog. One of these examples is BCOA member and longtime Borzoi owner Karen Haberkorn.



Karen and her dog Murray (left) just recently earned the Rally Champion (RACH) title and competed at the 2022 AKC Rally National Championship. Karen started competing in obedience 38 years ago. In the 1980s she

had a top-winning conformation dog, Hawkeye, that was her first dog that earned the obedience Utility title. That was only the beginning of her demonstration that a Borzoi is an excellent companion sport dog.

Following Hawkeye there was Nickie, who was not only a Utility (UD) title winner in Canada and the US, but an Obedience Trial Champion (OTCH) title winner in Canada. Nickie was followed by Rufus, a Utility Dog Excellent (UDX) title and a Rally Advance Excellent (RAE) title winner. The list continues with Jackie (UDX), and Bobby (UD and Obedience Master - pictured at right). Finally, there is Murray, who is only the third Borzoi AKC Rally Champion and is one leg from finishing the Utility title.

I asked Karen a few questions about her training with Borzoi:

How long have you been doing obedience and Rally? Karen: I have been doing Obedience for 38 years and Rally for 20.

What do you like about working with a Borzoi?

Karen: I like the challenge.

What were your challenges with training a Borzoi?

Karen: Borzoi do not like repetitive activity and it is hard to keep them motivated. A Borzoi sees no reason to do an activity more than once. Thank heavens Murray is a chow hound. Bobbie was my best working Borzoi.

What was your best moment in working in Obedience and Rally?

Karen: When Bobby finished his Obedience Master title; when Hawkeye won group and Novice B obedience in the same trial. Finally, my best Rally experience is Murray becoming a Rally Champion.

Do you have any advice for people who have Borzoi and want to do Obedience and / or Rally?

Karen: My best advice is never giving up and don't accept a lesser performance than if you had a Border Collie or a Golden Retriever!

Karen's repetitive success in competing in obedience and rally is only one example of a handler having success with a Borzoi. Any Borzoi can be trained and just as exciting as earning titles, Obedience and Rally training has wonderful benefits. Training



is a great way to set boundaries and teach the dog what is and what is not acceptable behavior in the home. Training can keep your dog safe as it has less of a chance to run off when it

knows how to react to commands such as "wait" or "come". Best of all, however, obedience training creates a strong bond and mutual trust between the dog and handler.

The 2023 National Specialty is in April. That is plenty of time to start training and enjoy the benefits of an obedient Borzoi. Start the training and come enter the Beginner Novice Obedience or Novice Rally. For those more-experienced trained dogs, come show how well a Borzoi can perform. Try it! You'll like it! §

"Zeus?" I was stunned. How could a dog scream like that and then be asleep? Zeus woke up and gave me a look that said, "Hi mom. It is night time, why are you here now?" Zeus was obviously fine. He must have gotten his foot stuck in the crate. I went back to bed.

Not long after that incident, there was another. Again, I was startled into waking by Zeus' screams. Again I ran to Zeus' crate. Again he was asleep. I called his name. This time, there was no response. Frightened, I opened the crate and stroked him, then gave him a little nudge.

Zeus came to. Other than taking a bit to come around, he seemed fine. But I was worried. Next vet visit I would mention these episodes as it seemed more than just a foot getting caught in the crate.

Not long after that, I entered Zeus in a match.

On the way, there seemed to be something wrong with Zeus. He seemed to be off somehow. His gums looked pale. Then they looked normal. Did I imagine the pale gums? When I got to the match site I tried giving him some water, which he refused. He seemed fine.

I took Zeus in and we sat down next to a nice woman with an Irish Wolfhound puppy. Zeus reached his muzzle out to sniff the pup, rocked to the side and fell over. I think he screamed but at this time, I am not sure. I get down on my knees; Zeus is not breathing, there is no pulse. A man comes and does CPR. It does not matter, Zeus is dead.

I was in total shock. Someone took me to her house. She called my vet's office for me and we waited until my vet called back. She did all the talking because I could not. My dead 10-monthold puppy's body was in the car.

The nice lady asked me if I thought I could drive. I said yes so she took me to my car and sent me off to my vet's office. My wonderful vet let me observe the necropsy. Gross observation of the organs revealed some petechial hemorrhaging on
several organs. There
was blood tinged froth
in the bronchial tubes.
These are typical signs
of sudden catastrophic
death. The heart looked normal. My vet took sections of everything
to send off but there was nothing to explain
Zeus' death.

My vet sent me out of the room. He was going to open the brain case. I think my vet was bound and determined to tell me what had killed my puppy. He was a good man.

The brain showed nothing.
Nothing
Nothing

The rest of the day I was just an automaton. This was the first major death I had suffered in my young life.

My 10-month-old puppy who I had totally fallen in love with was dead. Of nothing.

The pathology reports on the sections my vet had taken came back but showed nothing. My 10-month-old puppy who I had totally fallen in love with was dead. Of nothing.

Nothing

It was 1986 or '87. My life changed because of that shock in more ways than I will probably ever know. As I began to recover, the question kept nagging at me. What killed Zeus?

I started asking people at shows. Had they seen a dog die like this? Do Borzoi drop dead? The people at shows knew nothing about this. Then a woman walking down the street saw me and my dogs. "Oh Borzoi!" She exclaimed. "When I was a kid, my neighbors had two of these. One of them fell dead when it was jumping up and down at the fence." Really? We talked, but that was all she could tell me.

Someone new started showing in our area. He had a dog of bloodlines not typical of our part of the country. He explained that he was very glad to have gotten Horsa because he came from his favorite bloodlines.

Months later the man came to a show without Horsa, grief stricken. Horsa had just keeled over and died. We talked but that was all he knew, Horsa keeled over and died.

There were a few other instances like this that I ran into. But nothing really added to my understanding of what killed Zeus. No doubt the good people who showed Borzoi in my area got really tired of my talking about this and asking questions. But I kept thinking, surely someone knew something.

A friend's Borzoi bitch is found dead. My friend leaves Kaze in the yard and goes to the post office across the street. When she returns, the dog who had been fine when she left, was dead. Kaze's body was warm, her gums cyanotic. "She must have swallowed a wasp."

A friend of mine who also had purebred dogs and had worked at the large animal clinic at the vet school answered one of my inquiries by saying, "Everyone knows Borzoi have heart problems, Nancy."

What? The Borzoi breeders I had asked had said that heart problems were only in a few lines. I didn't know that Borzoi have heart problems, not as a breed-wide problem. Who are these people who know Borzoi have heart problems?

It was about that time when I started traveling to the vet school

for the weekend, staying at a hotel, and mining the vet school library for answers. I bought a medical dictionary, because what they were saying was mostly Greek and Latin to me. I would write the definitions of words I did not understand in the margins of copied articles. The first articles were covered with writing in the margins. With repetition, I started to understand. I spent a lot of money on the copy machines at that library. Then the veterinary library became the veterinary and medical library, so I followed it to its new location and still made periodic treks to mine for information.

From what I learned I decided that what I had witnessed was probably a sudden cardiac death caused by cardiac arrhythmias. I learned about Holter recordings. At the time, the research into what was then called Boxer Cardiomyopathy was still in its infancy as they struggled to answer the question of "what is killing Boxers?"

In 1988 the sire of my bitch, Vozha, was diagnosed with a heart problem. All I could get was that it was the kind of problem where the heart gets weaker and weaker until it fails. Nothing else.

Deedee, the young daughter of my male, Donner, has a seizure as the owner is walking to the car after her first show. Afterwards, she seemed perfectly fine. Later, Deedee was found dead in her dog house.

A friend's young Borzoi bitch was diagnosed with dilated cardiomyopathy but the problem did not sound like what Zeus

had died of. The problem sounded like what the sire of my Vozha had. Zeus' heart had not weakened, he had just dropped dead.

Then in 1993 I was out in the yard with the dogs when I heard a cry behind me. I turned and Charles was on the ground. His front legs were stiff and his head was arching unnaturally up and over his back. Then he was dead. Charles was 20 months old. He was the grandson and great grandson of my first Borzoi, Iva.

I called my vet and took Charles' body over. The gross necropsy showed nothing definitive. The pathology report on the sections showed nothing. There had been some remodeling of his heart valves but my vet did not think that was the cause of Charles' death. Other than that, the heart looked normal. Besides being too young to have remodeling of his heart valves, I was still left with nothing.

Then Charles' sister, Beauty, dropped dead two weeks later. She was owned by a friend of mine. He had come home; Beauty greeted him happily. He went into the house to get her dinner. He came out to feed her and Beauty was dead. He showed me the

necropsy report. Nothing. "My neighbor poisoned my dog." He claimed.

I started my questioning of people anew. Someone had to know something. Now I had two of these deaths and one of them had a sibling that had also dropped dead; this could not be that rare.

Still the same answers; nothing on dogs dropping dead but when I asked about heart disease I was told cardiomyopathy

was in a few lines but not here.

Now I was getting questioned back. Were there poisonous plants in your yard, Nancy? What are you doing that is causing this Nancy? Gee, why are you so unlucky, Nancy? I would deflect these questions to my vet. Is there a plant that could cause this? Can I be doing something to cause this?

No, there was no such plant in my yard.

No, there was nothing I was doing that could cause these deaths.

No

I turned and Charles

was on the ground.

His front legs were

arching unnaturally

Then he was dead.

stiff and his head was

up and over his back.

Not to mention, I did not live in the same place where the first sudden death had occurred and Beauty had never lived with me.

Then another friend's Borzoi bitch, Queen, dropped dead. There is no more information. All that is known is that she was alive and then she wasn't.

In 1997, I took time off to attend the BCOA National Specialty in Atlanta. Packing my car for the trip was a challenge. I was going to the front of the car to rearrange some things when I heard a cry. I ran around to the back of the car and my 10-year-old male, Donner, was on the ground, front legs stiff, head arching unnaturally up and over his back. I knew what was happening. I had seen it before. I dropped to my knees next to Donner and he was gone.

My vet was shocked when I called her. I took his body in and decided to go on to the National, because, what else was I going to do, sit at home and cry? So instead I went to the National and cried.

While there, my vet called me. She had found nothing. "I don't know what to tell you, Nancy. He had the organs of a dog half his age. He shouldn't be dead." By now, the pathology report gave me the expected information: nothing.

Now I had three dogs that had died suddenly and unexpectedly.

How could anyone be this unlucky? This had to be happening to other people. I knew it was happening. I had heard about it in

some dogs but still, no one knew of a problem in Borzoi that caused them to suddenly stop living for no apparent reason. Even my research found nothing about Borzoi. Nothing.

I knew the problem was around. I knew it occurred in a wide range of pedigrees. I knew I had it in the lines of dogs I was working with.

I decide to start over. For my next Borzoi, I looked out of state. I decided to be proactive this time. Through my vet, I got a referral to the local vet school for my new puppy.

It was 2000. I told the cardiologist my tale of woe and asked for a Holter test. He refused, because the auscultation had been fine. "Your dog has a healthy heart. He has a very slight murmur, but that is not unusual in a dog with a strong athletic heart," he said. I insisted. The cardiologist agreed to do an echocardiogram and then the Holter if it was medically indicated.

They took Sart back and I went to eat lunch. I returned at the appointed time to discover that my dog's heart was not quite as healthy as the auscultation led the cardiologist to believe. Sart had a heart string (chordae tendinea) tethered to the muscular wall between the large chambers of the heart (ventricular septum). It should have been anchored instead to the papillary muscle. These cords help to keep the valves from flipping into the atrium when they are supposed to be closed. This one, with its base misplaced, was keeping the valve from closing leading to mitral valve regurgitation. The leak was not bad but there was the possibility that the cord could break causing catastrophic failure of the valve and potentially death. There was also a risk of the regurgitation causing extra stress on the heart, eventually leading to congestive heart failure, though the cardiologist thought the

regurgitation was mild enough that outcome was unlikely.

They wanted to do a Holter. Great, I had wanted a Holter to begin with, though not for this reason.

They put the Holter on and sent me home. The results were not good. Memory fades but Sart had substantial arrhythmias. He was a year old. This taught me that auscultations could easily give a breeder a false sense of security.

That year, my 11 year old bitch, Star, wakes me up in the middle of the night with the urgent need to go outside. I let her out and go back to sleep. That morning I find her body curled up by the side of the house, one of the places where she would sleep when outside. I was sad, but she was 11, had lived a good life and was healthy right up until the end. That is how I would ask to go. There was no necropsy; after all, I thought she had died of old age.

I take Sart back to the vet school a year later. His heart was doing fine. The arrhythmias were a lot less frequent, but still there.

At three, Sart's arrhythmias were almost completely gone. I thought we were out of danger. Sart did live a very long life, but I know now that even though arrhythmias can seem to go away, they are not necessarily gone forever nor is the danger of sudden death completely gone. I wish I had kept taking him for more Holter tests just so I could

have seen if and when his arrhythmias came back.

I eventually got two bitches that I planned to breed. One stead-fastly refused to have seasons at times that would be workable for a litter. The other I bred. When planning the litter, I thought I did what I could to avoid sudden death in the puppies. I was a bit worried about bloat and osteo, though I thought the risk for those was low. Ironically, none of the pups ever suffered from either bloat or osteosarcoma. I raise the litter and was really pleased with the homes they went to.

It is hard to lose a dog, it is harder to find out one of the babies you bred and sent to be loved by a wonderful person is sick and will die an early death.

Morpheus had to have a tooth extraction. He went through the surgery well and recovery was good—until the evening before he was to go back to the vet for his recheck. He just wasn't doing right. The owner was concerned. I told her no need to go to the emergency vet, just don't miss his recheck.

The next day, Morph's vet listened to his heart. What he heard was alarming enough for him to hook Morph up to the ECG. What he saw on the ECG was bad enough that he sent it directly

to the local cardiology practice. What the cardiologists saw was malignant enough for them to tell the vet to send the owners and Morph to the cardiology clinic ASAP.

Two weeks prior, Morpheus had been on an ECG during a lengthy tooth extraction surgery and nothing concerning showed up. Suddenly, now, he was getting the red carpet and preferential appointments at a busy cardiology practice.

Morpheus had DCM. I contact the owners of the other pups and tell them to let their vets know that there is DCM in the litter. I send Morph's sister, Lightning, to another home. Her echo is fine.

Five months later, Lightning is at the vet with congestive heart failure. One day she was fine, the next she looked like she was 5 months pregnant. The appearance of pregnancy was fluid buildup in her abdomen because of her failing heart's inability to pump.

I contact all the puppy buyers again and tell them their vets needed to check their dogs for cardiac disease.

Morpheus dies. Suddenly. In his owner's arms. It is April of 2013.

In May, Hay Luz, my pick bitch and the light of my life, walks over to me to say hello, falls over and dies. I was on the phone with my mother at the time. Hay Luz was a sibling to Morph and Lightning.

I start taking Booker, another dog from this litter, to an echo clinic that was held at a nearby show every time it is offered.

March of 2014 Lightning dies due to DCM.

Because Booker and I were sad with Lightning gone, I get a male Borzoi puppy. His name is Drak.

On January of 2015, I take Booker for his echo at a clinic. We put him on the table and the moment the cardiologist sets the transducer on his chest we watch his heart go through multiple runs of fast tachycardia. The cardiologist was not taking readings at the time of the events but she estimated the runs were at a rate of 250 to 300 beats per minute. These were very dangerous runs and Booker was at risk for sudden death. We were lucky to have seen these runs because the rest of Booker's echo was completely normal. Without catching that glimpse of those arrhythmias I might have decided that Booker was out of danger and stopped doing those cardiac screenings. That would have been tragic.

This discovery ended our cheap screening echos and began twice yearly trips to the cardiologist for complete cardiac work ups including Holter tests.

It is 2017 and the Holter rental program began. I rent the Holter to do Booker's 24 hour ECG for his up coming cardiology visit.

I also Holter three year old Drak to enter him into the arrhythmia study. I send Drak's Holter report to my cardiologist so she will have a "baseline" for him.

I get a message from my cardiologist. "Drak needs to be put on an antiarrhythmic." "Why? His Holter isn't that bad!" She explains to me why Drak's unremarkable seeming Holter would cause her to put him on meds.

I argue with the cardiologist. "Drak is a very active, athletic three year old. There is nothing wrong with his heart."

We compromise. I will bring Drak in for an echo and then we will talk. His appointment is in two weeks.

October 9, 2017, not long after his most recent cardiology visit, Booker had to be put down because of a bleeding mass on his spleen. His heart had been relatively stable, he was aging well. Booker was 11.

October 18, 2017, Drak is diagnosed with DCM by echocardiography. I have a melt-down in the cardiology office that is fairly spectacular.

A friend offers me a female puppy. I tell her that, frankly, I was afraid of getting another Borzoi. She offers to get an echo on the bitch. I tell her I would rather have a Holter.

The puppy is 7 months old. Her Holter is perfect. I get the puppy because Drak and I need joy in our lives.

Miss Kav is perfect for both Drak and I. She and Drak play for hours at a time and her joyous personality constantly makes me laugh. She is beautiful, she is smart, she is everything I want in a bitch.

I take her to a lure course for the opportunity to practice. She is insane in her desire for the lure. I get excited. Maybe I have a running dog again! We get a chance to practice. Kav starts out well and runs about half the course and then stops. She wanders around, says, "Hi," to the judges. I am puzzled. How could a dog that was screaming with desire for the lure just stop like that? We try her again at the end of the day. The same thing happens. I go home perplexed.

It is time for one of Drak's periodic cardiology visits. I have rented the Holter so I can send the report to the cardiologist prior to our visit. I decide to Holter Kav as well to add to her previous Holter as we need periodic Holters on dogs for the study.

I get Drak's Holter report and it looks about the same as

it always does. I send a copy to Drak's cardiologist and to Dr. Gelzer for the Arrhythmia Study. I get Kav's report from ALBA on the weekend. As I am going through the steps of getting and opening the report from my e-mail I wonder if the folks at ALBA work on the weekends.

What I see makes my heart stop. Two runs, both over 250 beats per minute. One was 11 beats at 288 beats per minute. These are what cardiologists call malignant arrhythmias. Kav was 1 year and 8 months old.

I send e-mails to Drak's cardiologist with Kav's Holter attached telling them I want an appointment for her as soon as possible. There isn't anything I can do but wait as it is the weekend. I send Kav's Holter report to Dr. Gelzer for the study. Thirty minutes later I get an urgent e-mail from Dr. Gelzer telling me that the bitch whose Holter I had just sent needed to see a cardiologist ASAP. I had sent her at least a hundred Holters and had never gotten that message before.

The rest of the weekend was long and not pleasant. It occurred to me that the reason why Kav had pulled up in the middle of the

practice runs may well have been arrhythmias. I thought that I may have been very lucky that my Kav did not die on the coursing field that day. I had already had a dog drop dead at a public gathering, I sincerely never wanted to experience that again. That was a special kind of horrible.

Early Monday, I got an e-mail from Drak's cardiologist that Kav needed to be seen as soon as possible. The next Monday, we were at the cardiologist's office. As soon as she saw Kav's

heart with the ultrasound, my cardiologist said that it did not look like Kav's heart was contracting well enough. My heart sank but the cardiologist was just eyeballing the way the heart looked, so no time to panic yet. Kav's heart does measure within the normal range, but not by much. Yet she is still within normal. No DCM. Yet. Maybe no DCM ever. Only time will tell.

Kav is put on an antiarrhythmic drug. Even though this will not necessarily protect her from sudden death, it helps me to know I am doing something to keep her safe.

I have had 5 Borzoi die of sudden death: Zeus, Charles, Donner, Star, and Hay Luz. I used to say that I have had 4 Borzoi die of sudden death, but then a friend of mine asked me how old all of my dogs were when they died and what they died of. That sent me to all my dogs' folders. As I was looking through Star's folder and reminiscing about that beautiful, sweet bitch, I found my notes on her death. Astonished, I sat there holding Star's folder. She had been a sudden death. It made sense. She was closely related to both Kaze and Queen who had also died suddenly. Yet, I had not seen this death for what it was for 22 years.

How could I have missed this? Me, the person who is ultra paranoid about Borzoi sudden death, had missed a sudden death in her own dogs? But I had. Dying in their sleep unexpectedly when they have been healthy prior to death is one of the classic ways sudden death presents. So when I say that sudden death is cryptic and you may well have had some sudden deaths in your dogs that you have not recognized, I am speaking from experience. Because, believe me, If I can miss one of these deaths, so can you.

I have learned that because these sudden deaths are so shocking and seemingly occur with no cause, our brains search for answers. I have heard a long number of excuses for these deaths. I have made some of them myself. We do this not because we are attempting to hide the deaths, but because they are so traumatic our brain needs to find some reason why our dog friend is suddenly dead for no reason.

This makes it very easy to miss any sudden deaths that might have happened in one's kennel over the years. This is also why

I do not believe anyone lied to me when they said they had never heard of Borzoi dropping dead for no reason. That is what Star taught me; these sudden deaths are easy to miss. They can hide as old age, wasp stings, poisonings, freak accidents, any number of things. This is not to say that these non-cardiac causes cannot really be the cause of a dog dying suddenly. However, we have to guard against misidentifying sudden deaths because doing so hides the sudden cardiac deaths from our view. Our breed has a problem with sudden cardiac death.

If you have a dog who dies suddenly and unexpectedly, even if you think you know why, do a necropsy. Make sure you are right so that this problem cannot hide from you in plain sight. Protect yourself and your puppy buyers from the risk of this heartbreak. Identify sudden death and call it what it is.

We must face the disease and call it by its name. We cannot breed away from a problem we do not see.

I have had at least one Borzoi under the care of a veterinary cardiologist and on cardiac meds since February of 2015. In my last litter of 8 puppies, three were diagnosed with DCM and one was undiagnosed but dropped dead. Both dogs I have acquired since I bred that last, ill-fated litter has been diagnosed with cardiac arrhythmias and one also has DCM. I cannot articulate to you how concerned I am about the breed. I will use the word "very." I am very concerned. Though that is sorely inadequate.

From all my trips to take various dogs to see our cardiologist, I have learned that cardiologists earn every single dollar of what they charge. My cardiologist probably saved Drak's life. Had she

HABIT FORMING!

BOCK-WALLENDORF BORZOI

The company that I am writing about in this article has practically no information about it in my books. It was a small German company located in the region of Thuringia. It was founded in 1903 and its production included ornamental middle range porcelain. I do not know if they are still in business today, but would doubt it.

Four marks were used by the company but I have only seen pieces with the mark below.



This mark was registered on December 31, 1914

The region of Thuringia was the cradle of the Old World porcelain production. This region provided the materials needed to produce good porcelain and, in addition, it also had a large pool of cheap labor. Thuringia was the home of many good porcelain manufacturers. Among some of the best were Volksteadt, Gotha and Wallendorf (not the same Bock-Wallendorf).

I have enclosed photos of four examples of Bock-Wallendorf work.

Photo A is a hard paste porcelain of a nude and Borzoi. This piece is well done but one will note that the proportions of the woman and dog do not match. This piece used only two colors.

Photo B is an interesting pair of pieces. It is very well done and the detail is very nice. More color was used on these items, however, in my opinion, the grade of porcelain is different. Note that the position of the right front leg of the dog in the background is different on both pieces.



Photo C is a large piece. It is a high grade porcelain but has only two colors used. The treatment of the dogs is good and is one of my favorites. (There is a companion piece of two standing dogs which I have seen.)

Photo D is by far the best quality. The treatment and detail of the subject matter, girl giving treat to Borzoi, is of the best quality and the numerous colors used enhance its beauty greatly.

When you are out antiquing, keep in mind this little known manufacturer. Their quality and subject matter were almost as good as some of the other famous manufacturers and the prices of their pieces are far less.

not insisted that he be placed on meds, I would never have discovered his DCM as early as we did. Early detection is the key to longer survival times. Not every dog will live as long with DCM as Drak has, but the earlier you can identify the problem, the better chance your dog has of living as long as is possible with the disease. And once congestive heart failure starts, survival times are much shorter even with good specialty care.

I also learned what a life saver the Holter can be. That Holter was the information needed to get Drak the specialty care he needed. Without the Holter, I would have been completely ignorant of Kav's extreme risk of sudden death.

What were Drak's Holter results that prompted my cardiologist to want to put him on medications? He had 19 single VPCs and 1 pair. Just like with our stoic breed, some sick hearts won't give you many clues, so you need to be sensitive to the subtle clues you do get.

What were the results of Kav's Holter that caused such a stir and got her rapidly placed on antiarrhythmic drugs? She had 4 single VPCs, 1 pair, and 2 runs. Of course those runs rated pretty high on the scale of badness.

This is why I harp about paying attention to complexities (pairs, triplets, runs, and R-on-T) even if the number of VPCs is low and even if the dog seems super healthy. Both of my dogs seemed super healthy, yet they were not.

Drak and Kav are still hanging in there. Kav still does not have DCM but her numbers are really close to being equivocal. Drak's disease is slowly progressing, bit by bit, but the drugs are helping. Drak has been living with DCM for five years, he is 8 now. I never thought I would get to say he was a veteran. I am saying it now. Drak is a veteran!

Kav has been living with her heart condition for 3 years. The antiarrhythmic drug she is on has been keeping her arrhythmias tame though she still has them. Tame is good. I can live with tame.

My experience with my dogs, the dogs of my friends, and the tales of sudden death in Borzoi I have heard over the years has taught me that I am not unduly unlucky. I now know of several people who have had experiences with sudden death in their dogs similar to mine. I know a few poor souls who have had it worse. Perhaps it is better to say that some people are lucky because they do not know what I am talking about when I say we have a problem. From what I can tell, sudden death is in a wide variety of bloodlines world-wide and they happen fairly regularly.

These lessons inform the decisions I make with regard to cardiac disease in Borzoi. While I have learned a lot, I am still learning.

Because I am still learning, what I share with the Borzoi fancy may have inconsistencies. Please understand that this is because as I learn, the information I share changes. Also be aware that with the research going on into our breed's hearts, the recommendations for Holter interpretation and breeding strategies will change. The breeding recommendations I make will err on the side of preserving bloodlines and gene pool diversity. I believe this will protect breeders from removing dogs from breeding only to find later that the dog could have been bred. I do not want any dog to be removed from breeding unnecessarily.

I have received some push back from a few people about some of the recommendations, specifically the Holter guidelines. I know that asking anyone to be wary of a dog with a few PVCs and just one pair may seem a bit over the top when the dog seems perfectly healthy in every way. I get it. I completely understand. Remember, I was the one who argued with Drak's cardiologist about putting him on meds when his Holter showed only 19 single VPCs and 1 pair. There was no way I was going to put a healthy dog on meds. I am so glad I listened to the cardiologist.

Because as healthy as Drak seemed, turns out he was not healthy after all.

I ask you to remember the lesson Drak taught me. No matter how few VPCs your dog has, if there are any complexities, get an echo done.

Please, take this problem seriously. Remember, we are not at the point of removing dogs from breeding based just on the Holter unless that report would be deemed abnormal for dogs in general (and you see and discuss the results with a cardiologist). Also remember that even in lines with sudden death, not every dog will be affected. Don't radically cut dogs from breeding, do screen your dogs for heart issues, do share the results with others, and do breed prudently.

Borzoi love us unconditionally, let us work together to assure their hearts are healthy. §

Showing Borzoi in 1963

General (registrations, point scales, event entries)

Per an AKC report, there were 488 allbreed shows in 1963, compared to 479 all breed shows held during 1962. Total entries were 326,444, compared to 305,815 entries in 1962 (a 10% increase). The largest all-breed show in 1963 was Harbor Cities at Long Beach CA with 2689 dogs shown followed by the International Kennel Club of Chicago with 2373 dogs shown, then Santa Barbara CA, Westminster NY, Trenton NJ, Westchester at Purchase NY, Kennel Club of Philadelphia, Santa Ana Valley at Anaheim CA, Del Monte CA, and Orange Empire at San Bernardino CA. By breed, with over 20,000 entries were German Shepherd Dogs. The three varieties of Poodles had 19,736 entries, followed by American Cocker Spaniels, Dachshunds, Collies (Rough and Smooth), Boxers. Dobermans, Great Danes, Shetland Sheepdogs and Bassets. There were 1049 Borzoi entries ranking Borzoi 54th out of 114 breeds. 34 Borzoi finished their championships in 1963. The largest entry of Borzoi, 43, was at the June 1963 Harbor Cities show, for the Borzoi Club of California specialty.

Per an AKC report, 568,300 dogs were registered in 1963, compared to 516,800 in 1962. 230 Borzoi were registered in 1963 compared to 275 Borzoi registered in 1962. Borzoi were ranked in 68 place out of 115 breeds. Poodles were the most popular with 147,055 registered, followed by German Shepherd Dogs, Beagles, Dachshunds, Chihuahuas, Pekingese, Collies, Cocker Spaniels, Pomeranians and Boston Terriers. There were 270,750 litters registered. At the end of 1963, the American Kennel Club's Stud Book has risen to the grand total of 8,580,620 for

the 85 years of its existence. The stud book dates back to 1878 and the AKC was not founded until 1884.

In 1963, the country was divided into 5 divisions for points. The scale of points for Borzoi was the minimum 2/2 3/3 4/4/5/5 6/6 for West and South, Pacific Northwest and Hawaii. For Borzoi in the North and East division shows, it took 2 dogs/2 bitches for 1 point, 3 dogs/3 bitches for 2 points, 4 dogs/4 bitches for 3 points, 6 dogs/5 bitches for 4 points and 8 dogs/9 bitches for 5 points. (This division contained the states of WI, IL, IN, OH, MI, PA, NY, NJ, MD, VA, DE, CT, RI, MA, ME, NH, VT). For Borzoi in the California division shows, it took 2 dogs/2 bitches for 1 point, 3 dogs/4 bitches for 2 points, 6 dogs/7 bitches for 3 points, 8 dogs/9 bitches for 4 points and 10 dogs/11 bitches for 5 points.

The AKC was still allowing mixed classes. The July Seattle WA show had one Borzoi male and one Borzoi female shown in the same open class, with the female winning the 1 point. The Tampa Bay FL shows had several "low entry" breeds including Borzoi, with the class dogs and bitches shown together, with only one winning the points.

The motion was approved to form a committee to revise and update the old booklet which would include the Constitution and By-Laws. Irmgard Thompson reported on the plans for the 1963 Specialty. The motion was approved to include classes for veteran dogs and bitches 7 years and older, Stud dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, Team, and a parade of champions. The motion was approved that the club pay for the luncheon at the specialty.

The copper medals with the Borzoi head that the club had



ordered made, were displayed. The motion was approved to award a medal engraved with the date for best of breed and best opposite sex at the BCOA specialty. 48 ballots were received, opened and counted at the meeting.

New members approved were Richard Hutchinson of Winston-Salem NC, Charles Scott of Long Branch NJ, Ruth Burch of Ocean Grove NJ, Betty Krause of Marmora NJ, Albert Denk of Chicago IL.

The Borzoi Club of Northern California specialty was approved for the Golden Gate show in January 1964. The annual awards for last year were presented. The 1962 winner of the Presidential Obedience award is Gladys Dykstra with Lady Tasha of Kamaroff UD with an average score of 192.7 (in utility and open B classes).

March 3, 1963 Board of Governors meeting held at the Americus Hotel Allentown PA. Present were John Gamber, Weldon McCluskey, Clarence DeCraene, Leonard Tamboer, Lorraine Groshans, Irmgard Thompson and Lydia Suchoff. Guests were Mary Gamber and Lena Tamboer.

Field Trials and Racing: Phydelma Gillette, Joanne Weaver, Grace Dusenbury, Eli Fleisher, Eugene O'Neill. Obedience: Gladys Dykstra, Gwen Pinette, Joanne Weaver. Annual Awards: Lena Tamboer. 1963 BCOA Specialty show chair-

man (Eastern show): Irmgard Thompson. 1963 specialty (Midwest show) Harry Ferguson. Membership: Weldon McCluskey, Lena Tamboer, Helen Colstad, Phydelma Gillette, Erma Denton. Match Show: Al Groshans. Annual Awards Revisions: Lena Tamboer, Weldon McCluskey, Clarence DeCraene Betty Forry, Harry Ferguson, Phydelma Gillette.

The motion was approved to stop work on the Borzoi book, and instead, to finish and publish the booklet. The booklet committee of Lorraine Groshans, Gwen Pinette, Weldon McCluskey and Louis Murr will be assisted by a representative from each of the three regional clubs (James Barr, Helen Colstad, Lyle Gillette). It was reported that the original Borzoi head die has been located at a Philadelphia company that makes the medals. It was decided to order silver medals for best of breed and bronze medals for best opposite sex, using that die. The copper medals already purchased will have pins on the back and will be used for club pins, and also can be sold to members for \$1.50 each. Mrs Robinson will have a table at the specialty with items the club has for sale, notepaper, seals, the copper medal pins and Borzoi prints. The motion was approved to change the policy on condolences from the club, to sending a condolence letter rather than flowers.

May 25, 1963 Board of Governors meeting held at the Monmouth NJ show site, after the specialty. The application of Frederick Hinckley of Salt Lake City UT would be approved once he acquires a Borzoi. Motion approved that the purchase of the club medals made up in silver and bronze will only be used by the club. The copper medals are being sent to new members and are available for purchase. The booklet committee reported that the booklet should be completed by the first of next year.

May 25, 1963 Membership meeting held at the Monmouth NJ show site, after the specialty. Present were Grace Dusenbury, Lydia Suchoff, Irmgard Thompson, Albert & Lorraine Groshans, Patti Robinson, Margaret Horstmann, Gladys Dykstra, Polly Clement, Lena Tamboer, Jessie Hamersma, John & Mary Gamber, Clarence DeCraene Weldon & Katherine McCluskey Eli Fleisher, Harry Ferguson, Bill Shepard.

Weldon McCluskey reported that he had received two recommendations for changes to the By-Law, establish an associate membership, and that to be an active member the person must own a Borzoi.

Eli Fleisher offered his farm as the location for a coursing event in the fall. The rules would be the same as for the coursing trials held by the Borzoi Club of California. Mr Ferguson reported on the plans for a second specialty, to be held September 21 with the Sewickly kennel club in western Pennsylvania. That kennel club will provide seven silver trophies for the top placings and \$50 cash prizes and will pay for the judge. The motion was approved to have Leo Wilson judge. The show committee (Irmgard Thompson, Lydia Suchoff and Clarence DeCraene) were thanked for the luncheon, and having the benching at one end of the rain tents which provided relative quiet.

Lorraine Groshans reported on the July 21 match. Entry fee will be \$1 and the judge will be John H Cook. Lorraine Groshans reported on the progress of the booklet. The chapter on history and legends of the breed will be written by Helen Colstad, James Barr will write the chapter on breeding, care and grooming, Lyle Gillette will write the chapter on racing and coursing. Glady Dykstra will compile material from Sylvia Sohr and Joy Zangwell on obedience. The motion was approved to send an agenda to all members prior to the membership meeting. Members were asked to vote for their first, second and third choices of a judge for the next specialty.

The motion was approved that the president be able to sign checks and that the president be bonded for the same amount as the treasurer. The motion was approved to donate a silver Borzoi medal for BOB and a bronze Borzoi medal for BOS at Westminster. There was a discussion about incorporation of the club. The booklet is almost completed. The motion was approved to charge \$40 for each page of advertising. A report from Gwen Pinette stated that the costs of having the Aristocrat mimeographed had risen from \$2 a page to \$3 a page. A motion was approved to pay the increase. A motion was approved to table the report from Lena Tamboer on revising the annual awards rules until the December meeting following publication of the report in the October Aristocrat.

Eli Fleisher reported that the coursing meet scheduled for October has been cancelled. Eli received a letter from the Pennsylvania Game Commission Field Service that "Game laws state it shall be lawful to hold field trials where dogs are permitted to work on liberated or native wild game in exhibition or contest, provided due diligence is exercised by those directing such a meet, to prevent the injury or killing of the game being pursued". Second, Eli was informed that he would need to purchase a permit from the Pennsylvania Department of Health to import wild hares into the state, which he had arranged to do, from a dealer in Kansas who would supply 12 jack rabbits for \$30. Third, Eli was told that the Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals would object to his event. The motion was approved to cancel further action on coursing until the club is protected by incorporation or liability insurance.

Editor's note: When Edward Abblett joined BCOA his sponsor, Helen Colstad, wrote the BCOA secretary stating that she had known Ed for 3 years and that he currently owned Ch Don's Zephora of Malora, Malora's Deacon of Aristoff, Malora's Sparkle of the Don and Perchinoff Zagor O'Zcerlov. Helen Colstad also wrote a recommendation for Renee Smith's husband, Toxey Smith's BCOA application. Helen stated that Toxey "was a highly successful attorney with offices in Hollywood. They own a beautiful estate east of the Sierra Madre Mountains as well as extensive acreage in the desert. Besides their Borzoi, Ch Campaigners Alix and her puppies, they breed cockers."

The Mid-West Borzoi Club's request to hold their specialty with the International Kennel Club of Chicago, April 4-5, 1964, was approved. A letter from the AKC was read informing the club that the offices of the AKC would be moved to 51 Madison Ave New York City next spring.



The motion was approved to grant Lorraine Groshans life membership. The motion was approved that the club incorporate in Pennsylvania as a non-profit organization.

There was a discussion about the annual awards revisions. There will be four annual awards for 1964, plus the obedience award which was not changed. The top winning Borzoi, will be awarded to the Borzoi accumulating the greatest number of points by virtue of 1st in the Hound Group and Best In Show wins. Points to be tallied according to greatest number given in Hound Group and Best In Show (the Phillips system). Best of Breed award to be given to the dog or bitch, gaining the greatest number of points by virtue of Best of Breed only. Best of Opposite Sex award to be given to the Borzoi of the opposite sex to the best of breed winner gaining the greatest number of points by virtue of Best of Breed, Bred By Exhibitor award to the Borzoi gaining the greatest number of championship points from the Bred By Exhibitor class. Not changed is the rule that only Borzoi owned by BCOA members are eligible for the annual awards. The plaque for a Best In Show win will no longer be awarded. The secretary will submit the descriptions of the annual awards to the AKC, and once approved, will notify the membership. The motion was approved that the club send the, owner of each new champion and the, owner of each Borzoi which has earned a UD degree, with a bronze club medal. The cost estimate of \$600 to print 600 copies of the booklet by the Chidabee Printing company of West Hill Ontario, was accepted. One thousand copies of the booklet will be ordered. (Editor's note: this is the 84 page paper back "The Borzoi" 1963 pedigree book).



Editor's note: In the 1963 file of Minutes and Letters is a report from the BCOA Field Committee "A Proposed Chapter On Sight Hounds for the Rules Applying to Registration and Field Trials" of

the American Kennel Club. Section 14. "Hounds shall be tested and judged on Jackrabbit (Hare) or any other game approved by the American Kennel Club Board of Directors for the area in which the meet is held." Of course, the AKC never recognized this type of coursing test on live game. It would take 10 more years, and the invention of a lure machine, to establish lure coursing on an artificial lure as a sport. Then many of the 1963 BCOA Field Committee's rules for Governing Sight Hound Coursing Meets would be used for the first lure coursing rules of the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA).
