

# Borzoi beauty, performance and breeding value assessment in Russia

by Natalia Romanova, August 2023

n the FCI standard No. 193 / 04.09.2019, Russian Borzoi in Russian language (country of origin of the breed and the holder of the standard) indicates "With working trial", and in translation into other official languages of the FCI, this paragraph has been changed to its opposite in meaning: "without working trial". In my opinion, this is a fundamental moment for understanding the breed, setting priorities during the examination of Borzoi in the show ring and evaluating the exterior in terms of its functionality.

The purpose of this article is to acquaint fanciers of the Russian Borzoi abroad with the methodology used for assessing the breeding stock and working qualities of dogs that exists in Russia in parallel with the FCI regulations for dog shows and competitions in coursing (racing).

The RKF (Russian Kennel Federation) and FCI show regulations are well known; therefore, I will focus only on dog shows and field trial regulations of the RORS (hereinafter referred to as the Hunting Union), since it has fundamental differences, in particular, a comprehensive assessment of dogs by exterior, working qualities, origin and descendants (bonitirovka). Understanding these rules is important for judges and breeders who see exhibitions not only as a beauty contest and handler competition, but also as an assessment of the breeding stock.

#### Historical information about dog shows and stud books

In the 19th century, dog breeding and cynology in Russia were closely associated with hunting with Borzois. There was the Imperial Society for the Breeding of Game Animals and Proper Hunting, which was engaged not only in compiling hunting regulations, but also in conducting field trials, competitions and dog shows. It was the Imperial Society that held the first dog show in Russia in December 1874, at which only hunting breeds were



presented for evaluation by the Judging Commission: 17 groups of Borzois, 40 hounds and 39 gun dogs. Since then, hunting dog shows were held regularly until the 1917 revolution, and they resumed in 1923.

In 1958, the Union of the Hunters Society was created, which united regional organizations of hunters, and in 1962 became known as Rosokhotrybolovsoyuz, abbreviated as RORS (Hunting Union). This organization maintains a database of hunting dogs, conducts dog shows and field trials, and issues documents for hunting dogs.

The All Russian Stud Book of Hunting Dogs (VPKOS) determines the procedure for registering, systematizing, and accounting for the origin of dogs. It has been conducted since the beginning of the 1990s by the Department of Hunting Dog Breeding of the Rosokhotrybolovsoyuz (RORS), continuing the recording and numbering of the All Russian Pedigree and Breeding Book of Hunting Dogs (VRKOS), which was maintained after 1917 by the Vsekohotsoyuz and served as a continuation of the Genealogy Book of the Moscow Hunting Society (RKMOO). In turn, the genealogical book of the Moscow Hunting Society (RK MOO) was kept from 1890 and was a continuation of the English Stud Book traditions in Russia.

After 1962, only the dogs with a full four-generation pedigree, an exterior evaluation of at least "good" and a diploma in field trials could be recorded in the All Russian Pedigree and Breeding Book of Hunting Dogs. For the record, it was necessary to send the Rosokhotrybolovsoyuz a genuine certificate of origin for a hunting dog and a copy taken from it, certified by the organization in which the dog is registered (for a dog imported from abroad, it was also necessary to send a photocopy of the pedigree with which it arrived in the USSR)

If the dog subsequently received more field diplomas, changed its class, or it had a qualified offspring, then all additional information about it should be sent to the Hunting Union to replenish the information in the VRKOS database.

Because earlier clubs and regional cynological organizations kept their own stud books and issued pedigrees, there was no single database and the RKF, since the date of registration in 1996, did the same. In 1999, the RKF entered into an associate membership agreement with the FCI, and since 2002, only the RKF, and not its member organizations, has the exclusive right to issue only the RKF, and not its member organizations, has the exclusive right to issue pedigrees. Since 2003, the RKF has become a full member of the FCI and is guided by its main provisions in the organization of dog shows and breeding.

# Abstracts from dog show regulations of the Hunting Union (RORS)

Dog shows in accordance with the regulations of the Hunting Union (RORS) are carried out in order to:

a) determine the quality and assess the hunting dogs by compli-

ance to the breed standard, type of constitution and exterior;

- b) monitor inherited traits in young dogs and take this information into account when making mating plans and further use of breeding dogs;
- c) demonstrate achievements and promote purebred hunting dogs;
- d) identify the best dogs in terms of breed type, type of constitution and exterior and determine by the quality of the progeny the correctness of their selection, according to the exterior;
- e) encourage owners of the best breeding dogs.

The regulations for judges in accordance with the "Rules for exhibitions of hunting dogs held by Rosokhotrybolovsoyuz" and "Breed Standards of hunting dogs" are the following:

- a) all dogs in the ring are examined both in motion (walking, trotting) and in free standing (Note: the dogs are moving following each other in a circle around while the judge determines a mark and placement for each dog in the class, asking the owner to move ahead by one or a few dogs. At the end of judging the class, all the dogs are lined up, starting with the class winner, followed by others with "excellent", then with "very good", etc.)
- b) a standing dog is examined in a natural pose that does not distort its actual shape and build;
- c) ) examination of teeth and bite is done before the final placement of the dogs.

The judging is carried out during daylight hours (Note: outdoors in any weather). Dog evaluation (judging) under artificial lighting is not allowed.

When conducting an examination of dogs in the conformation ring, both features that are closely related to the constitution and physical development, as well as specific characteristics of each breed, are taken into account. The dog in the ring should be considered with all his qualities, failings or faults, as a whole, and not regarded by separate, isolated, positive or negative features.

Dogs from 10 months to 10 years old and puppies from 4 to 10 Continued on page 12

months old are allowed to enter the show and are divided into the following age groups:

- a) young: from 10 months to 1.5 years;
- b) intermediate: from 1.5 to 3 years;
- c) adult: from 3 to 10 years.

The judge is obliged to compare the tattoo (dog identification) with the number indicated in the document and make a note about it in the evaluation sheet.

Depending on the qualities of the conformation and constitution, the dogs in the conformation ring are awarded marks: "excellent", "very good", "good", "satisfactory". In the younger age group, the mark "excellent" is not awarded. Puppies under 10 months of age do not receive conformation ratings. They are reviewed by a judge by the litters and individually. The expert in the report gives an opinion on the compliance to the breed standard of the puppy, its development, as well as the expediency or inexpediency of repeating the mating from which these puppies were born.

At the end of the examination in the exterior evaluation ring, the expert proceeds to a **comprehensive assessment** of dogs (**Annex 2**) and determination of their breeding class and ordinal places in the class based on the data of evaluation sheets, submitted certificates and other documents, in accordance with the rules of exhibitions (rules of exhibitions (**Annex 1**).

# **Borzoi breeding classes**

A comprehensive assessment of dogs is made up of assessments for the following indicators:

- a) hunting qualities
- b) breed type, constitution and exterior
- c) origin
- d) offspring

Dogs of the younger, middle and older age groups that have diplomas for field trials recognized by the RORS and received at this show a rating of at least "good" are subject to a comprehensive assessment.

#### Prior to the show, preliminary data on dogs is being prepared

For each recorded dog in the evaluation sheet (see Appendix), sections are filled in:

- 1 general information
- 2 origin
- 3 list of qualified descendants of the dog.

On the conformation ring, the show judge and assistants clarify the data of the evaluation sheets and fill in section IV of the evaluation sheet and paragraph 2 of section V for breed, constitution and conformation in accordance with the assessment received at this show

# Ancestors are evaluated: maximum 20 points based on:

Evaluation by origin is made on the basis of the dog's pedigree, confirming its origin and the presence of ancestors of the next four generations (parents, grandfathers, great-grandfathers), as well as the field and conformation assessment of the parents.

- a) the presence of parents (father and mother), 1 point each (1X2) = 2 points;
- b) if the parents have an assessment for the exterior (obtained at the events of RORS not lower than "good", not lower than "good", two points are added for each parent (2X2) = 4 points;
- c) ) if the parents have a field trial diploma (obtained at the events of RORS or recognized by it), 2 points are added for each (2X2) = 4 points. Total maximum for parents (2X5) = 10 points;
- d) in the presence of grandfathers and grandmothers, 1 point each (1X4) = 4 points;
- e) in the presence of great-grandfathers and great-grandmothers, 0.5 points each (0.5X8) = 4 points;
- f) in the presence of great-great-grandparents and great-great-grandmothers, 0.125 points each  $(0.125 \times 16) = 2$  points. In the absence of one of the ancestors, the other ancestor of this pair is not taken into account.

#### **Evaluating dogs of foreign origin**

In the case of a dog of foreign origin, the first generation ancestors take into account the available conformation and hunting qualities assessments according to the table "Designations of field tests (tests) of hunting dogs conducted in FCI organizations and equated to the presence of a field trial diploma for the ancestors of the first generation of the pedigree (parents).

#### **Evaluating hunting qualities**

When evaluating hunting qualities, only two field trials diplomas

of the highest degree are taken into account, the main and additional (repeated).

Depending on the degree of the diploma for hunting qualities, the main points are set:

- a) FIRST degree the highest) 40 points;
- b) SECOND degree 35 points;
- c) THIRD degree 30 points.

For dogs from pairs and packs of sighthounds, the main points for the diplomas received in the group test are given in full, as in individual tests or competitions. An additional diploma (repeated) is any diploma of the highest degree. An additional point is counted on the basis of the next highest degree diploma received by the dog for work, regardless of whether it was received alone, in a pair, pack, and is established: for a diploma of the 1st degree 10 points; for a diploma of the 2nd degree 8 points; for a diploma of the 3rd degree 5 points.

### **Evaluating dogs by offspring**

When evaluating dogs by offspring, only their direct descendants (children) who have a field trial diploma alone in profile types of tests and an exterior grade of at least "GOOD" are taken into account and evaluated. Only six best descendants are taken into account as much as possible (maximum 36 points). For each such offspring, both male and female, points are counted according to the following table:

When assessing "SATISFACTORY", no points are awarded and points for the hunting qualities of the offspring are not taken into account.

#### Points for conformation

The point mark for conformation is given on the basis of the mark obtained by the dog only at this show. The following points are awarded for the marks obtained at the show: 1. EXCELLENT: 40 points; 2. VERY GOOD: 30 points; 3. GOOD: 20 points.

#### **Breeding classes**

In accordance with the tables of minimum requirements for determining the class, attached to these Rules (Appendix No. 1), dogs are divided into four breeding classes: "class ELITE", "FIRST breeding class", "SECOND breeding class", "THIRD breeding (reserve) Class". Determination of the breeding class (bonitation) of dogs is made by an expert in the ring. For dogs passing to the "ELITE" and "FIRST" classes, an entry in the All Russian Stud Book of Hunting Dogs (VPKOS) is required. For dogs that have breeding documents of countries with organizations of which there is an appropriate cooperation agreement, an entry in the national studbooks is taken into account. The place of each dog in each class is determined in accordance with the total score for a comprehensive assessment.

The highest place in the class is occupied by the dog, evaluated by the highest total score as a result of the comprehensive assessment. If the total scores are equal, the question of the dog's place in the class is decided depending on the scores in four sections of the comprehensive assessment in the following sequence: 1) by offspring; 2) by hunting qualities; 3) on the exterior; 4) by origin. If all these indicators are equal, the dog that takes the best place in the conformation ring at this show has the advantage.

# Rules for field trials (testing of hunting performance of Borzois on a free prey)

- Field trials of sight hounds are carried out on an adult hare and on a fox living in a wild (Comment: No captured or domesticated animals can be used or released in the field trials).

Trials are carried out mainly between October 1 and December 1, depending on local conditions. Each dog that passes the performance test in the trials receives an individual rating. Two or three dogs (pair or pack) belonging to the same owner can also receive a group performance evaluation as well as the individual one, provided they are kept on the same leash (rope)

Dogs are not judged and dismissed from the trials in the following cases:

- The dogs are launched on the prey that got up against the neigbouring pack of dogs. Dogs are launched on a young (baby) animal or at a distance closer than 25 m.

- The dogs returned from the pursuit of the prey leaving it in sight, having galloped no more than 200 m.
- The hunter (handler) deliberately did not let the dogs follow the prey that got up within the limits established for distance test (up to 100 m.
- Dogs attack domestic animals A dog tearing a caught prey is not awarded diplomas.

Hunting qualities demonstrated at the field trials are estimated according to the following table of maximum points



# Not all that glitters...

icture this: It's December 25, 2023. The candles are lit. The newly decorated balsam tree, mounded with ornaments, garlands, tiny lights and tinsel, sits in the living room. Bing Crosby sings on the radio in the background, wishing everyone to have a Merry Little Christmas. The table is set with your best dinnerware and polished silver. In the center of the beautifully set table is a golden cooked turkey surrounded by dishes of candied yams, lovely cooked vegetables, mashed potatoes, gravy, a clove studded ham, cranberry relish and stuffing. Several kinds of pies sit on the sideboard.

Just as everyone raises their glasses of wine to toast each other and wish everyone a Merry Christmas, you hear the sound of your beautiful Borzoi Sasha barfing in the kitchen. You're all startled and somewhat embarrassed and go to check on him to see if he's all right. To your horror, he's regurgitated not only some brown substance that is probably from the platter of chocolate

fudge squares, but something glittery, which is most likely something from the beautifully decorated Christmas tree in the living room.

According to Pat Bailey writing on the UC Davis website (Dec. 2012) "...the holidays are filled with traditional foods and decorations" and "those same items can cause harm to your pets if ingested. Every year at the UC Davis William R. Pritchard Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital, veterinarians treat pets that get sick from eating the holiday decorations and treats." She also quotes Karl Jandrey, an assistant professor of clinical small animal emergency and intensive care at UC Davis, who said "most of the items ingested are only minimally harmful. However, some seemingly harmless holiday items can cause internal damage or even death to your pet." If you are a longtime Borzoi owner, you probably know most of the holiday items considered harmful to your dog if ingested, but here is a short list as a reminder or for those new to the breed.

- Food such as chocolate, sweets, and other baked goods; turkey skin, turkey or table scraps; yeast dough
- Decorations like tinsel, ornaments, water additives to the Christmas tree, candles, electric lights, flowers or festive plants, potpourris
- Hosting a party or having guests over? Watch the exits. Even if your pets are comfortable around guests, make sure you watch them closely, especially when people are entering or leaving your home. While you're welcoming hungry guests and collecting coats, a very fast fourlegged family member may make a break for it out the door and become lost. Also, your dogs should have access to a comfortable, quiet place inside if they want to retreat. Make sure your dog has a room or crate somewhere away from the commotion, where your guests won't follow, that it can go to anytime it wants to get away. If guests ask to bring their own dogs and

# HABIT FORMING!

#### CHALK IS .....

Chalk statues date back quite a few years and were produced in Europe as well as the U. S.. They were popular during the 1920's, 1930's and again in the late 1950's to mid 1960's. A help in distinguishing the early statues from the newer ones is the finish. The older statues, of better quality, had a pearlized finish that in some cases is close to an enamel. With age and wear this finish will flake and peel like paint. The carnival statues were mass produced and are of lesser quality. There were often airbrushed with glitter added. The animals were usually marked with blotches and blobs of color. These pieces also appeared at dime stores and souvenir booths. I remember seeing several Borzoi figures when I was a child at both the Virginia State Fair and various souvenir booths.

The dating of pieces can not be done purely by the "style" or look of a piece. Many of the earlier pieces have been mass re-produced within the past few years. Two prime examples of this are the "Sultana" and "Southern Bell" statues. Most of these copies are made in Mexico and can be composed of several different things including chalk, plastic polymer, alabaster, and salt. Recently though, a friend found two lovely chalk statues in the French Quarter. They are not Mexican copies but American reproductions. The finish is not pearlized but it is of the same type as was used on the earlier pieces. The women in these statues are colored mostly white with only little other color; eyes, hair, lips and skin on the woman.

Some of the older chalk pieces are signed and dated. Some of the pieces made in the U.S. will carry the year and the company name as well as a copyright mark. One of the

most expensive chalks actually has a thin metal covering This covering is usually copper and so these statues will lool like bronzes at a quick look. They are nicely detailed European chalks are less common in the U.S. and to my knowledge we have none in our collection.

I have enclosed some photos of some different chall pieces in our collection. This is by no means even close to all the chalk statues made. We have several that we have no gotten photographed yet and I am aware of numerous others that we do not have.

As I said earlier, there are numerous chalk pieces that are not shown or discussed in this short article. Probably the most copied of the chalk statues is the one I call "Southern Bell". We have them in everything from chalk banks, white ceramic ware, to the later "fair" pieces. Very new copies of this piece are now appearing. One interesting thing is that there was a companion piece of a man and Borzoi. These are not common and are unusual.

Chalk has been a medium that has enjoyed different periods of popularity and despite its fragile nature much of it has survived to the present. It again is becoming quite collectable causing the prices to rise and I am sure that it will continue to be popular among Borzoi Collectors.

FIGURE 2 is also an American piece. This is very similar to the Sultana piece, however it is larger and has only one dog. When I got this piece it had been broken. I was able to repair it, but I changed the color as it was an ugly green. The Sultana piece I referred to dates from the 1930's and as stated before has been highly copied. One can be seen as a prop in the original movie "Flamingo Row".

FIGURE 5 is a signed Santini and copyrighted under General Art Company. I think that it is an American piece but is not marked as such. It can be found in numerous colors.



FIGURE 6 is a new piece made by Carol Harvey from an old mold. It is decorated with hand rubbed chalk colors. The older piece has a heavier "enamel' type finish and was more detailed.

FIGURE 7 is a silhouette lamp. This also comes in numerous colors but some do not have the lace work painted on the woman's skirt. It does not have any copyright marks or company names on it. I would guess that it is American from the 1950's



FIGURE 8 is probably an old homemade piece. The painting of the features on the woman and the dog and the type of paint are not what you would find on a commercial piece. There are no copyright markers but the letter M appears on the back of the piece.



FIGURE 9 shows another unmarked piece. I think that it is an old American piece judging by the finish. It is one of the "Standard Borzoi" poses; however it is much larger. It is larger than the doorstop of the same pose, nine inches at the withers.



FIGURE 10 comes in several colors also. The dress in this figure is done in pearlized paint as well as the flowers. It is probably American made but has no marks.

These pieces are signed Paul Herzel and are probably from the same period as the statue mentioned above. (figure 11)



# The True Cost Of A National Specialty

ince taking over the role of National Specialty Chair/ Show Secretary, I am often asked about the costs associated with the National Specialty. Although each venue presents its own unique challenges, the bottom line is that we rely on our membership for their support and donations to enable us to bring you the specialties you have enjoyed in the past and expect in the future. I hope you will take a few moments to review the 2023 National Reconciliation (opposite page).

# The Details:

The Founders Inn and Spa, our lovely 2023 venue in Virginia Beach, VA, required us to have grooming outdoors. Because of our April dates, and the uncertainty with the weather, we needed to rent a tent for grooming. Additionally, to ensure we had electricity for the blow dryers in use, we had to rent an electrical bank for the week (total cost for both was approximately \$10,000). The facility also required us to cover the ballroom floor and any areas where dogs would be present with plastic at the cost of \$8,000. The only concession they allowed was the actual ring which required some negotiation and an additional cleaning charge of \$500 plus tax and service charge (\$640).

Hospitality is an important part of our National. We want everyone to feel welcome and enjoy the experience of the National celebration of our beloved breed. This year was no exception. Although we had several donations specifically earmarked for hospitality, you can see that hospitality costs take a substantial chunk out of the profits. It is wonderful to have the opening reception and I think many enjoy the Friday night social event. However, the continued escalation of costs may mean it may have to be scaled down or eliminated completely.

When negotiating with hotels, we contract for the number of hotel room nights we will need. Because we are working two years in advance, it is merely a guestimate of what we may be able to fill. For that reason, we always encourage our membership and exhibitors to stay at the host hotel. Not only is it convenient, but the paid room nights also affect our potential costs (or credits) towards the cost of the ballroom, clinic rooms and seminar rooms. Fortunately, although we had a high room count (using the last numbers from Gettysburg, 2019) we were able to make our numbers. The hotel comped the ballroom and gave us a credit of almost \$1,800. As a club, we use the credits to help offset the costs of our judges' rooms.

The POD continues to be a huge expense. For those of you that are not familiar with the POD, it is our portable storage unit that contains our perpetual trophies, ring gating, obedience and rally equipment, excess specialty sales items, bathtubs, hot water heaters and grounds items. The cost varies from year to year, depending on the distance required for POD transportation. There has been much discussion regarding the need for the POD but as

witnessed in 2023, without the timely arrival of the POD, we had a mad scramble to locate bathtubs, hoses, pooper scoopers, poop bags, ring gating and obedience and rally equipment in time for the start of our event (all at an additional cost).

# Where You Can Help:

When at all possible, stay at the host hotel. We work hard to negotiate reasonable rates that allow multiple dogs per room with minimal dog fees.

you don't know how the dogs will get along, you should either politely decline their request or plan to spend some time acclimating the dogs to each other, supervising their interactions, monitoring for signs of a problem, and taking action to avoid injuries to dogs or people.

- Trash also should be cleared away where our incredibly tall dogs can't reach it – especially sparkly ribbon and other
- packaging or decorative items that could be tempting for your dog to play with or consume.
- Plan in advance. Make sure you know how to get to your 24/7 emergency veterinary clinic before there's an emergency. Plan your travel route so you're not trying to find your way when stressed. Always keep these numbers posted in an easy-to-find location in case of emergencies:
- Your veterinarian's clinic phone number
- 24/7 emergency veterinary clinic (if different)
- ASPCA Poison Control Hotline: 888-426-4435
- Pet Poison Helpline: 855-764-7661

# I. General (Borzoi registrations, point scales)

Borzoi had 760 registration ranking 59 out of 115 breeds. 909,300 dogs registered in 1968. 263,700 poodles in first place, German Shepherd Dogs in Second place 104,127, followed by Dachshunds, Beagles, Chihuahua Miniature Schnauzers, Pekingese. Collies, Labrador Retrieves, Cocker Spaniel. The largest entry of Borzoi, 124 with 114 shown, was at the MBC specialty in Detroit in March 3

Effective May 15, 1968, the schedule of points increased. For Borzoi in Division 1, it took 2 dogs/2 bitches for 1 point, 3 dogs/3 bitches for 2 points, 5 dogs/5 bitches for 3 points, 7 dogs/7 bitches for 4 points and 12 dogs/13 bitches for 5 points. (This division contained the states of WI, IL, IN, OH, MI, PA, NY, NJ, MD, VA, DE, CT, RI, MA, ME, NH, VT). The scale of points in Division 2 for Borzoi was 2/2 3/3 5/5 8/8 11/12 for West and South (WV KY TN NC SC GA FL AL MS LA AK OK TX NM AZ MN. For Borzoi in the California division shows, it took 2 dogs/2 bitches for 1 point, 5 dogs/4 bitches for 2 points, 10 dogs/8 bitches for 3 points, 14 dogs/10 bitches for 4 points and 17 dogs/12 bitches for 5 points. The scale of points for Division 4 stayed at the minimum 2/2 3/3 4/4/ 5/5 6/6 (ND SD MT WY UT NV ID OR WA).

# II. New Titles For Borzoi in 1968 (D)=dog (B)=bitch

74 Champions finished during 1968. The AKC published registered name, registration number, the sire and dam with their registration numbers, and the stud book dates. There are no stud book dates for the sire and dam of imported dogs. For Obedience titles the AKC published the registered name and registration number. The editor has added sex (D) or (B), date of birth, breeder, owner, and the BCOA Registry of Merit title (if any).

The title date is the publication date in the AKC Gazette, minus 2 months, since it took 2 months for results to be published in the *Gazette*.
